The venue in Arbanasi offers fantastic facilities for organization of such events – send and grass arenas, excellent accommodation of horses and people, tracks for canter.

The Level 1 course is very good tool to put in a frame the knowledge of the coaches.

The endurance in Bulgaria is developing very well last year. The profile of the athletes/ coaches is very different that the Olympic disciplines. Before to come at the endurance most of the athletes/coaches do not have horse background. This has positive and negative side. One of the positives is the fact that these people are open to learn.

For most of them, the fact that they need flatwork (dressage) was surprising.
