<b>Entry Requirements for Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>18 years old and over</li> <li>Have a knowledge of horses and horsemanship (responsibility of the NF)</li> <li>Have completed an FEI Introduction to Coaching course</li> <li>Have a First Aid Safety certificate (recommendation)</li> </ul>

<b>Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be registered with their NF</li> </ul>
