<b>Participation</b>	Open to FEI Level 1 Judges recommended by their NF, and National Level Judges from NFs with equivalency of their education system approved by the FEI. Limited to min. 10 and max. 15 participants on a first come first served basis (max. 6 per hosting NF and max. 2 per other NF if the total number reaches 15). <b>Minimum qualification criteria:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To have been an FEI Level 1 Judge for at least 2 years OR <i>If equivalency has been agreed with an NF on its national education system for Judges, it is the responsibility of the NF to nominate applicants to the FEI courses</i></li> <li>• In the two years prior to application to have acted at least six times as member of the Ground Jury at major national events or international events</li> <li>• To have worked within a Course Designer's Team during an entire major event, preferably international. This must be noted in the Logbook and signed by the Course Designer</li> <li>• To have assisted a Chief Steward during an entire event run under FEI Rules, preferably international. This must be noted in the Logbook and signed by the Chief Steward</li> </ul>
