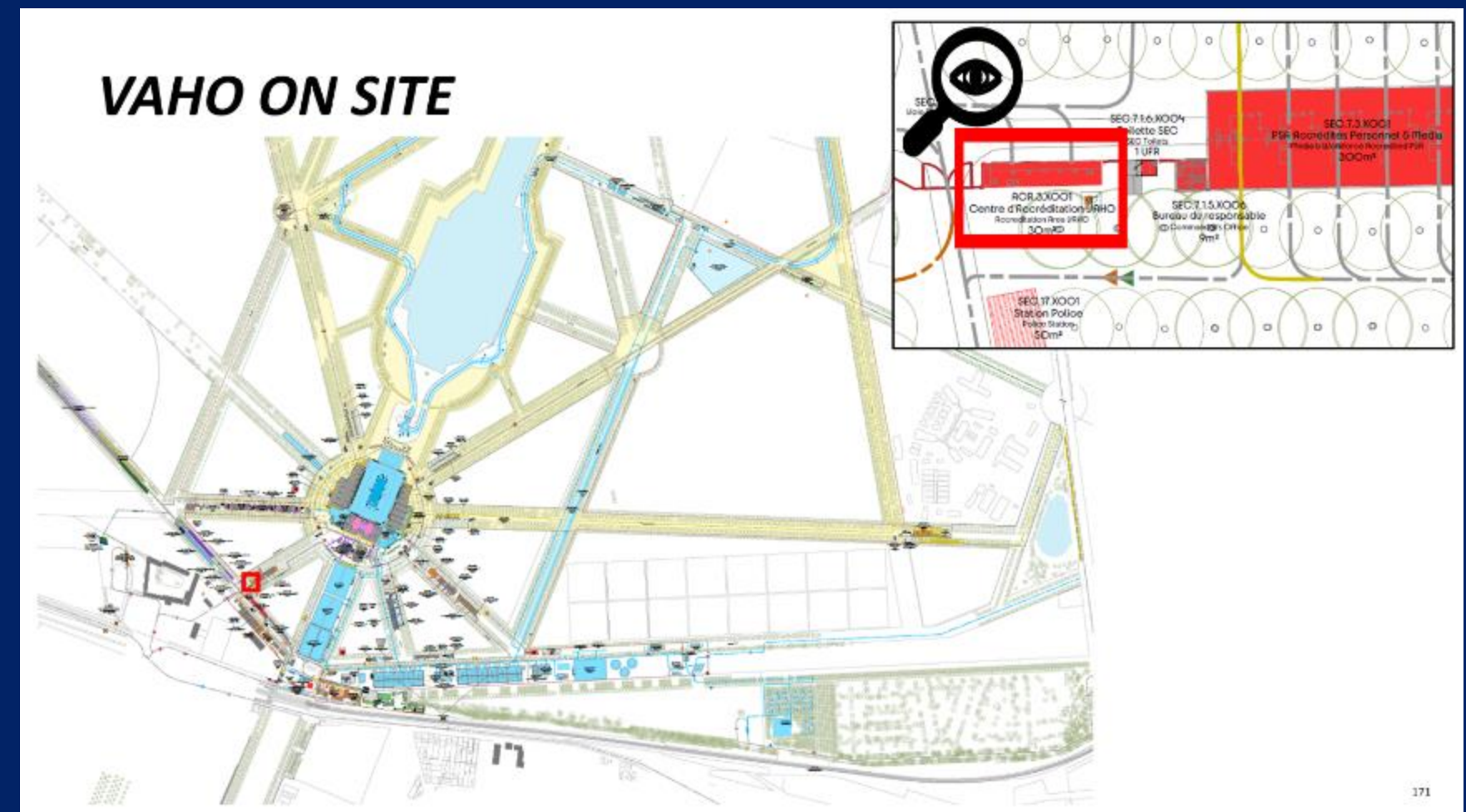
NEXT STEPS

SAME FOR NPC WITH PIAC

Next steps :

NOC completes and submits "Application for Accreditation" forms through the OCOG online system within the agreed deadline.
OCOG confirms data validity and facilitates security risk assessments and visa/entry authorisations.
OCOG and NOC schedule pre-DRM to review applications submitted, resolve outstanding issues, discuss/adjust any category and venue access changes, determine "knife and fork" entitlement requirements for populations not automatically entitled and to cancel applications no longer required to reduce the size of the "long list".
OCOG prints PVCs of the fully registered delegation members and sends to NOC.
NOC distributes PVCs to delegation members before travel to the Host Country of the Games.
NOC continues to refine and, if applicable, finalise (at the D-DRM) its delegation's accreditation needs with the OCOG.
OCOG and NOC confirm eligibility of all delegation members at the F-DRM. Any outstanding "NOC Conditions of Participation" forms are provided to the OCOG Accreditation area at the F-DRM.
The bearer of the PVC proceeds to a validation counter or accreditation centre or the participant is invited to collect their accreditation from an accreditation centre (only after completion of the respective NOC's F-DRM).
Accreditation is issued and validated or PVC is validated at a validation counter or accreditation centre and becomes an OIAC. The accredited person attains access to all rights granted by the OIAC.

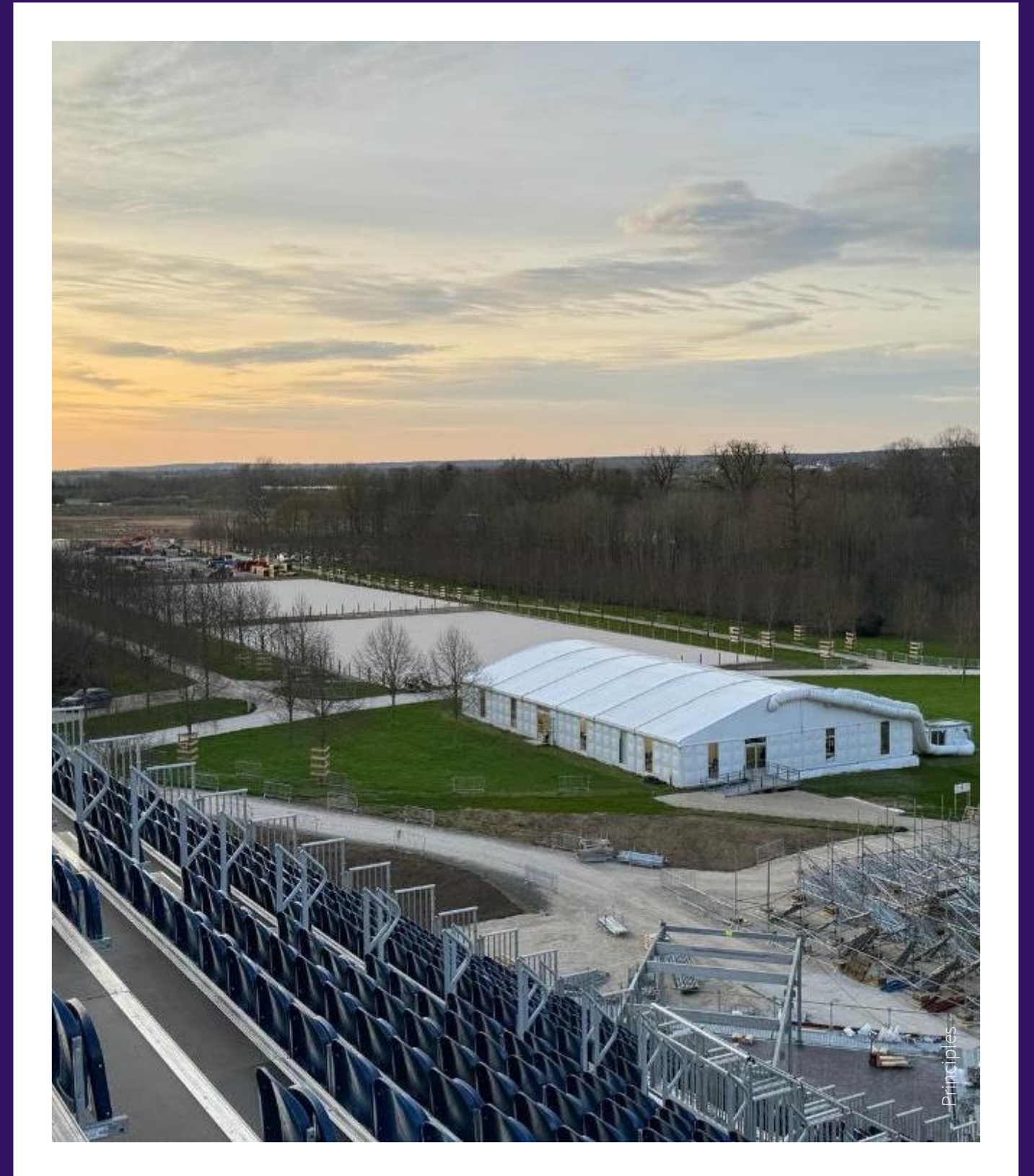

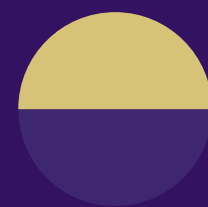
Replacing the TAP from Tokyo 2020

- Allow access to specific venues for personal coaches, support personnel and training partners :
- “P” accreditations will not be considered when calculating the bed allocation in the Olympic Village(s) and will need to make their own provision to obtain a visa to enter French territory.
 - Please note that “P” accredited persons do not have access to the Athletes Lounges, the Olympic or Paralympic Village
 - Please note that “P” accredited persons do not have access to the Same Discipline Athletes tribune.
 - “P” accreditations will only be available to NOC/NPCs who have filled their “Ao” quota
 - “P” accreditations are nominative and non-transferrable.

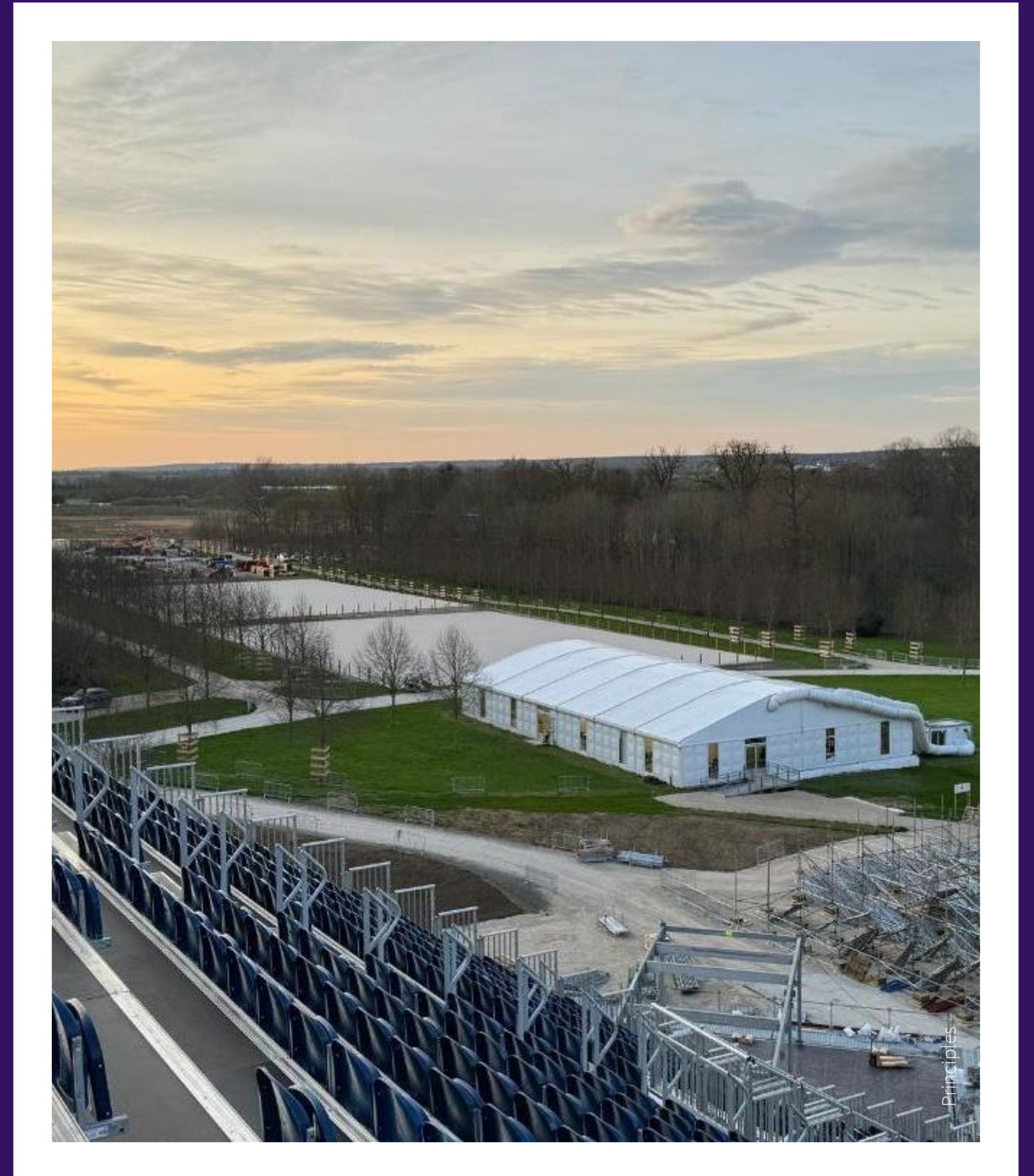
To access to the stables, holders must wear OIAC + stable pass during OLY and must wear PIAC + stable pass during PARA.

Needs to approved shortly with FEI

The Stables SACD will be distributed to holders of Equestrian (EQU) Olympic/ Paralympic Accreditation as follows:

- Category Ao (population including Coach, Team Leader, Technical Personnel, Administrative Personnel, Veterinarian)
- Category Aa (population: Athlete)
- Category Ap (population: Alternate Athlete),
- Category Ao (population: Groom)
- Category P (population: Alternate Groom)
- Category NOC/NPC (population: Horse Support Personnel).
- Categories: NOC/ NPC (populations other than Horse Support Personnel).

For P Accreditations and the latter categories/populations and any other Olympic accredited guests/VIPs that an NOC/NPC may choose to invite into the stables compound additional stables SACDs will be distributed accordingly to the number of entered horses per discipline (amount TBD).

- Transition EVE to EJP : for delegations with eventing and jumping teams, the tack rooms can be kept, and the equipment can remain in them. However, we will be disinfecting all the boxes adjacent to the tack room. It is therefore your responsibility to leave equipment in full knowledge of this.
- Awaiting a validation for preopening on the 23rd for equipment – needs to be manage within your allocated place
- Next EFM version coming soon (feed and bedding, laundry, saddlery process)
- Stable team help with loading and unloading equipment
- NOC/NPC storage – tack/equipment storage of min. 4m² per Horse for Olympic Games and 6m² per Horse for Paralympic Games, space for NOC/NPCs to locate own storage containers/facilities

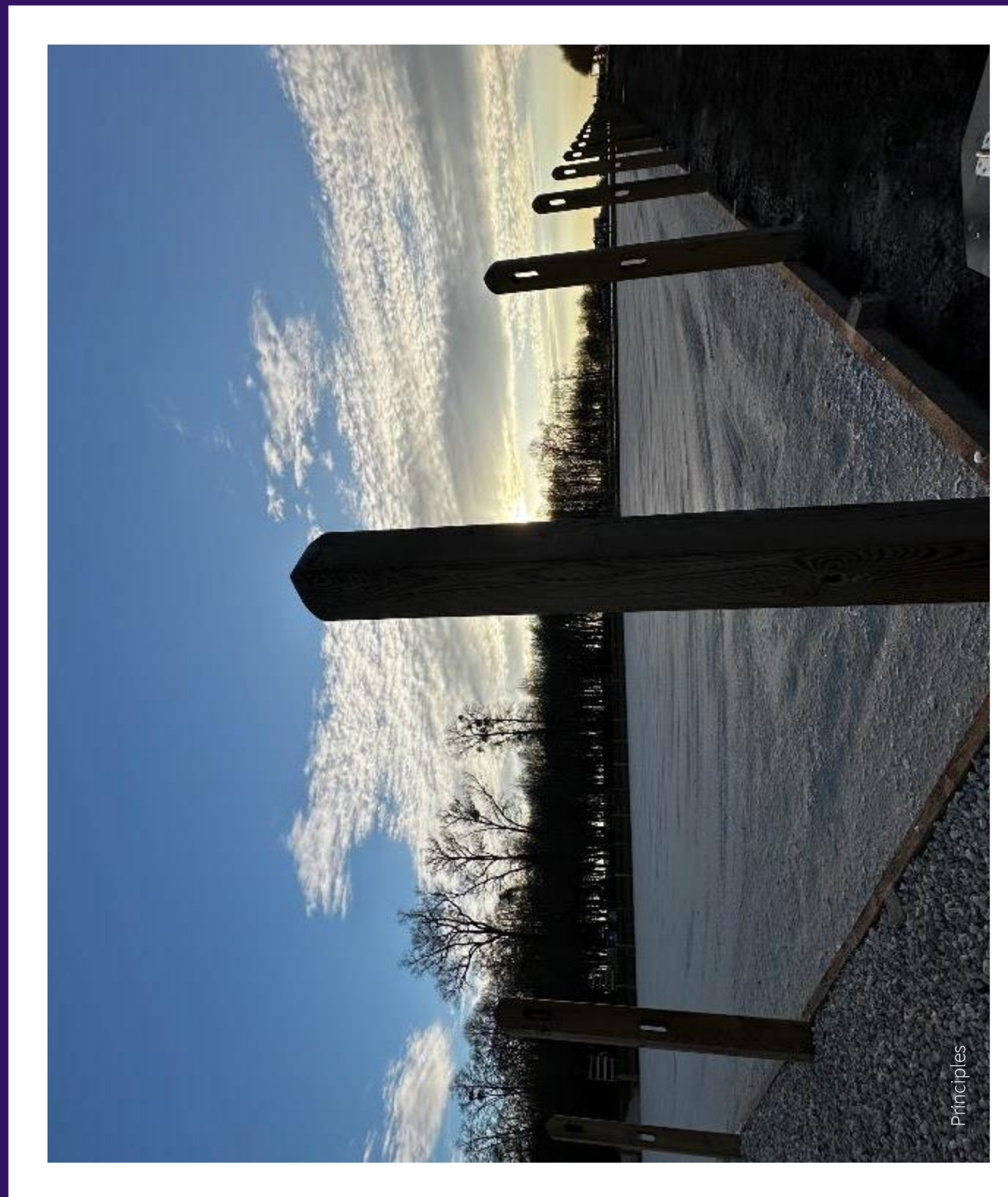

POWER SUPPLY & LOGISTICAL COSTS:

Power supply can be purchased if required (**ONLY 32A P17 witch 3,5KW available**)

While storage of the container on site is free of charge, the installation and removal of the container in the dedicated space will incur logistical costs.

Rates will be communicated.



PRIVATE GENERATORS

The NFs asked about the possibility of bringing their own generators to be self-sufficient with their truck.

Answer from the site safety officer:

I don't see any constraint on horse trucks starting up their own generator integrated into their truck. It's an installation designed for the usual use of trucks if the generators are already integrated.

However, it will be necessary to :

- provide portable extinguishing equipment (powder or multi-purpose extinguishers) in the area where the trucks are parked
- ensure that the gensets are properly earthed
- prohibit all hydrocarbon storage in the area

Next step : EPV needs to be involve in the final decision

Reminder : The truck occupancy does not substitute to the Groom's Village package
(*Package Mandatory*)





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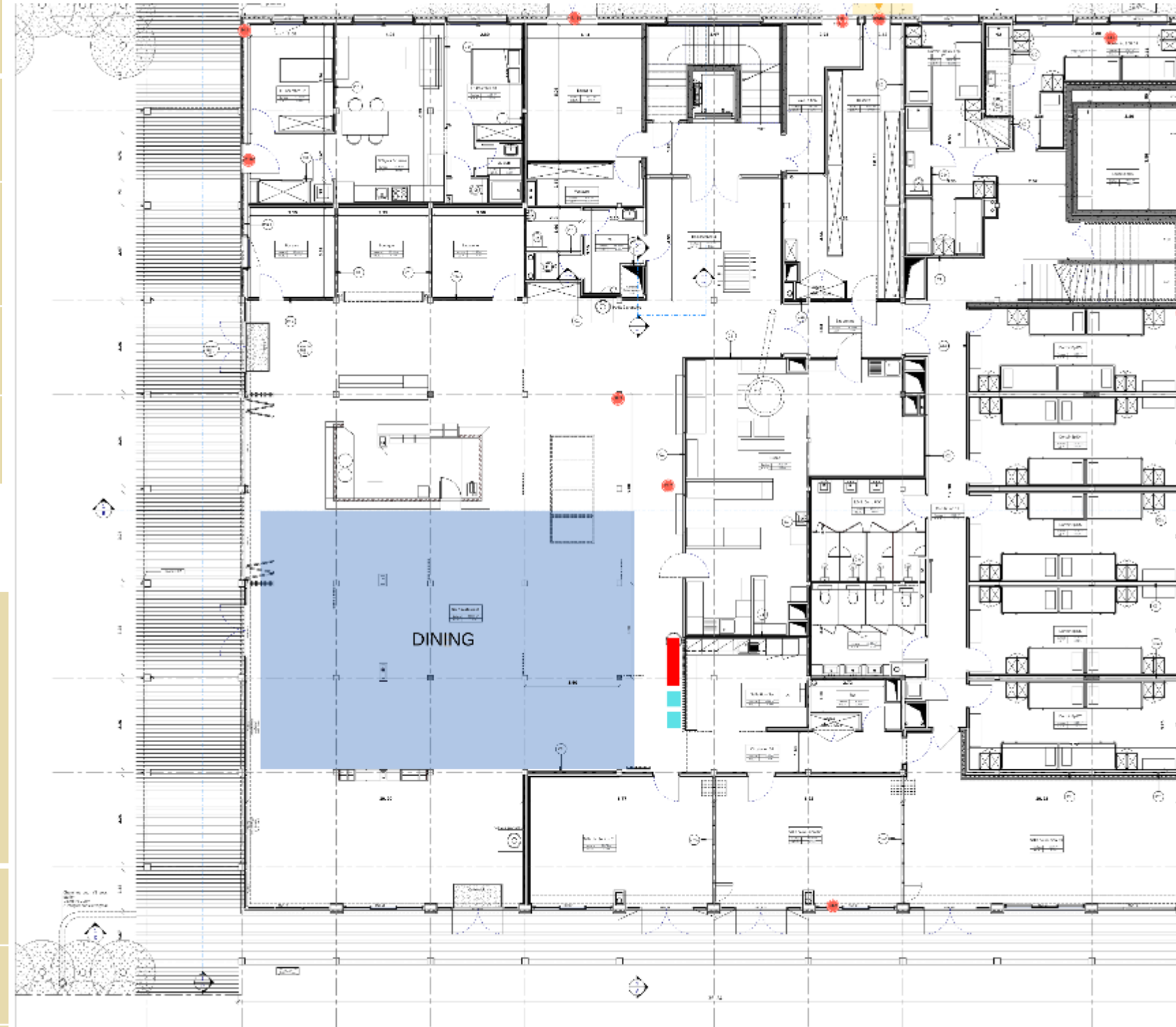

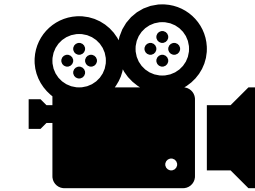

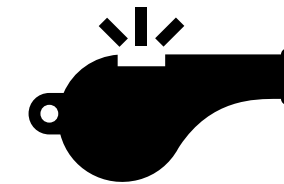
