Ground Jury Member - President of the Ground Jury - Foreign Judge - Limb Sensitivity Judge

Requirements

- ✓ English proficiency grade of C1 or higher
- ✓ FEI Level 3 Judge for a minimum of 4 years
- ✓ Be in good standing with the FEI
- Officiating experience within 10 years of application**
- ✓ 5x CSI4*/5* or CSIO3*/4* as President of the Ground Jury
- ✓ 3x CSIO5* as Foreign Judge (appointed & officiated)
- ✓ 1x Senior Championships, Games, World Cup or Longines League of Nations Finals as a Ground Jury Member (appointed & officiated - Limb Sensitivity Judge excluded)

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 6 Intl. Events within the previous 3 years as a Level 4 Judge, of which a minimum of 3 CSI4*/5* or CSIO3*, or above

Education

For Transfer-up

- ✓ Pass the Transfer-up Level 4 Judges Education with examinations:
Pass the online problem-solving case studies
If passed, invited to an online interview
Pass an online interview
If passed, the Official is provisionally transferred up to Level 4
Pass a three-day in-person course at FEI HQ
If passed, the transfer-up to level 4 is confirmed

- ✓ On passing the Level 4 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 4 Judges in the FEI Database

- ✓ 6 Intl. Events as a Ground Jury Member within the last 3 years

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 3 Intl. Events within 3 years as a Level 3 Judge*

For Transfer-up

- ✓ Pass a Transfer-up Level 3 Judges Course with examination

- ✓ On passing the level 3 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 3 Judges in the FEI Database.

- ✓ Completed online Jumping Foundation Course
- ✓ Passed online Level 1 Judges Equivalency examination

For Level 1 Judges

- ✓ English proficiency grade of B1 or higher
- ✓ 1 year & 6 Intl. Events as a Level 1 Judge

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
 - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
 - ✓ 3 Intl. Events within 3 years as a Level 2 Judge*
- *condition non applicable to Equivalency Officials for the initial 3 years of officiating.

For Transfer-up

- ✓ Pass a Transfer-up Level 2 Judges Course with examination

- ✓ On passing the level 2 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 2 Judges in the FEI Database.

- ✓ Completed online Jumping Foundation Course

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
 - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
 - ✓ 3 Intl. Events or FEI Challenges, within 3 years as a Level 1 Judge*
- *condition non applicable for the initial 3 years of officiating at level 1.

For National Judges from NFs with Equivalency

- ✓ Pass an online Transfer-up Level 1 Judges Course with examination **and** an online interview **or** pass an in-person Transfer-up Level 1 Judges Course with examination

For National Judges

- ✓ Pass a Transfer-up Level 1 Judges in-person Course with examination
