1. Qualification period

Start: 1 January 2017

End: 31 July 2018

2. Qualification criteria

To be applied in conjunction with Art. 913 and 914.1-6 of the FEI Driving Rules.

Drivers:

Open to Athletes who meet the following criteria:

At two (2) different International combined driving events, 3* Drivers must achieve a score of 65 points or less in the Dressage test 3*B HP1 or 3*C HP1 and have successfully completed (without Elimination, Disqualification or Retirement) all three competitions (Dressage, Cones, Marathon) in their own class.

One of the qualifying result as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1st January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

Art 914.2, Qualification results can be obtained at CAIO4*, CAI3* and CAI2* (see Article 913) – for Single Horses.

Maximum Driven penalty points allowed at the Championships in Dressage as per Art 914.4: **70** points

Dressage 3*B HP1 will be run at the Championships.

Article 943 Participation

1. Method of Driving

1.1. Athletes may use any method or style of driving.

2. The Athletes and Grooms participation:

Article 116 of the FEI General Rules:

8. Unless otherwise provided in the Sport Rules, an NF cannot make definite entries for the same Athlete/Horse combination to more than one (1) OC for the same time period on penalty of disqualification of such Athlete/Horse combination from the event in which they eventually participate.
