Recommendations for Rules amendments for 2018

Introduction

Please find below the Reining Technical Committee's proposals for changes and clarification to the Reining Rules for 2018.

The rationale of the Reining Technical Committee for proposition their amendments are indicated in italics and in purple.

REINING RULES – main modifications and amendments proposed for 2018

Chapter II – STRUCTURE OF COMPETITIONS

Article 301.5 FEI WORLD EQUESTRIAN GAMES AND CONTINENTAL/WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Days are replaced by Competition + number

A rest day must be scheduled, preferably between competition 2 and competition 3.

Reining Technical Committee: the two amendments/clarifications allow for more flexibility for the Organisers.

CHAPTER V Horses

Article 313 conditions of participation

313.1 Each Horse may only start in ~~one Competition per *level, per day, and in~~ a maximum of two separate Competitions per day.

Reining Technical Committee: the RTC does not wish to restrict Athletes sharing a horse, e.g. a Senior Athlete riding a Horse in a CRI2 and a Junior Athlete riding a Horse in a CRIJ2* at a same Event.*

313.4 Following the Horse Inspection: Any Horse(s) taking part in a CRI/CRIO may only be ridden by the Athlete(s) who will ride the Horse in the Competition. The penalty for violating this rule shall be immediate Disqualification

Reining Technical Committee: related to the above amendment.

313.8 All Horses entered in FEI Reining Events must be registered as Horses with the FEI. Ponies are not allowed.

Reining Technical Committee: Horses registered as ponies are not admitted.
