Simon's Horse Shop Tour (for Young Horses)

Leading 5, 6 & 7 year old horse over all CSIYH1* of Bonheiden will receive horse equipment for the total amount of €1.000.

PRIZE – CLASSIFICATION – POINT SYSTEM: "Simons Horse Shop Tour"

- Points may be earned in all young horses competitions of all 7 shows: 21 five year old classes, 21 six year old classes and 21 seven year old classes.
- In each Young Horse competition at the Events 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7 the young horses will receive points as follows:
 - In competition I, II, III, IV, V, VI, 10 horses will receive points as follows: the winner will receive 10 points, 2nd 9 points, 3rd 8 points, ...
 - In competition VII, VIII & IX, 15 horses will receive points as follows: the winner will receive 15 points, 2nd 14 points, 3rd 13 points, ...
- In each Young Horse competition at the Events 5 & 6 the young horses will receive points as follows:
 - In competition I, II, III & IV, 10 horses will receive points as follows: the winner will receive 10 points, 2nd 9 points, 3rd 8 points, ...
 - In competition V & VI, 15 horses will receive points as follows: the winner will receive 15 points, 2nd 14 points, 3rd 13 points, ...

The best 10 results of each age category will count; in any case for the purpose of establishing the final classification, no more than 50% (rounded up to the next whole number) of the total number of competitions that have taken place for each age category may be taken into account. In case of a tie for the first place the horse with the greater number of first place classifications in competitions offering 15 points to the winner will be placed first; in case of a further tie, the greater number of second placings (counting for 14 points) will be taken into account and so on until the tie is broken.

- Points may be earned in all ranking competitions of all 7 shows. In total this is 16 classes, 2 at events 1, 2, 3, 4 & 7 and 3 at event 5 & 6. In each ranking competition the 10 first placed riders will receive points as follows: 1st 20 points, 2nd 17 points, 3rd 15 points, 4th 13 points, ...
- In the Grand Prix of events 5 & 6 the 10 first placed riders will receive points as follows: 1st 30 points, 2nd 25,5 points, 3rd 22,5 points, 4th 19,5 points, ...

The best 8 results will count; in any case, for the purpose of establishing the final classification, no more than 50% (rounded up to the next whole number) of the total number of ranking competitions that have taken place may be taken into account. In case of a tie for the first place the rider with the greater number of first place classifications will be placed first; in case of a further tie, the number of second place classifications will be taken into account and so on, until the tie is broken.
