I understand and agree that it may be necessary for TUE-related information submitted prior to revoking my consent to be retained for the sole purpose of establishing a possible anti-doping rule violation, where this is required by the Code.

I consent to the decision on this application being made available to relevant National Federation and all ADOs, or other organizations, with Testing authority and/or results management authority over me.

I understand and accept that the recipients of my information and of the decision on this application may be located outside the country where I reside. In some of these countries data protection and privacy laws may not be equivalent to those in my country of residence.

I understand that if I believe that my personal information is not used in conformity with this consent and the International Standard for the Protection of Privacy and Personal Information I can file a complaint to WADA or CAS.

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## Appendix 1

### NOTE TO PRESCRIBING PHYSICIANS From FEI Medical Committee

You have been identified by a rider/equestrian athlete as the prescribing physician for a substance which is prohibited in sport. The rider/athlete has requested a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) from the Medical Committee of Federation Équestre Internationale (FEI) as is by the FEI's Anti-Doping Rules for Human Athlete.

As part of the TUE approval process, we want to make sure that riders/athletes who are using chronic narcotics are carefully monitored for side effects and safe usage. It is our goal to make sure that riders/athletes are not "riding while impaired", as this may place the rider/athlete, their horse, and even other riders and course officials at risk for serious injury or death.

Please be aware that your endorsement of this rider/athlete's application for a TUE for a substance that may have an impact on judgement and performance means that you are aware of and agree to the following:

- The rider/athlete has been prescribed regular or routine use of this medication by you for a chronic condition that cannot be treated with other non-prohibited medications;
- The demands placed on the rider/athlete by his/her particular sport were taken into account when the medication was prescribed;
- The rider/athlete must be monitored for signs of toxicity, intolerable side effects, or misuse throughout the course of the treatment;
