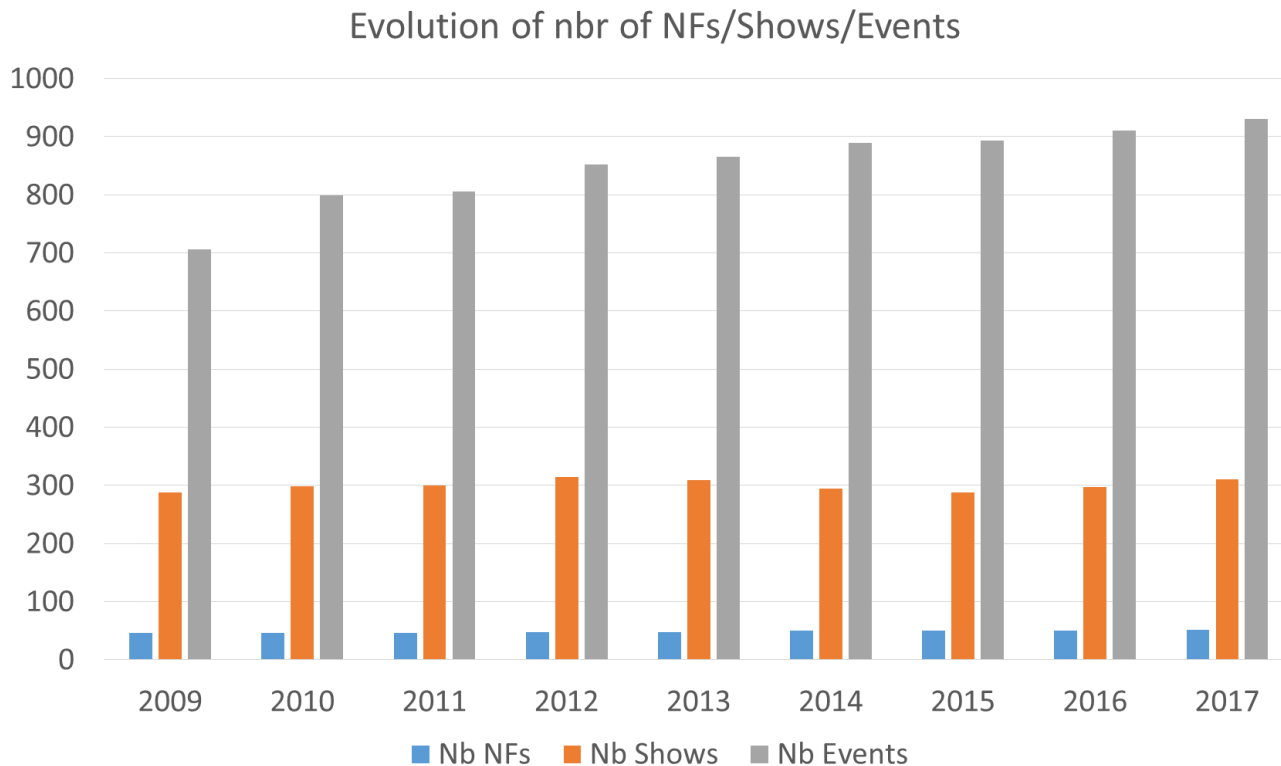

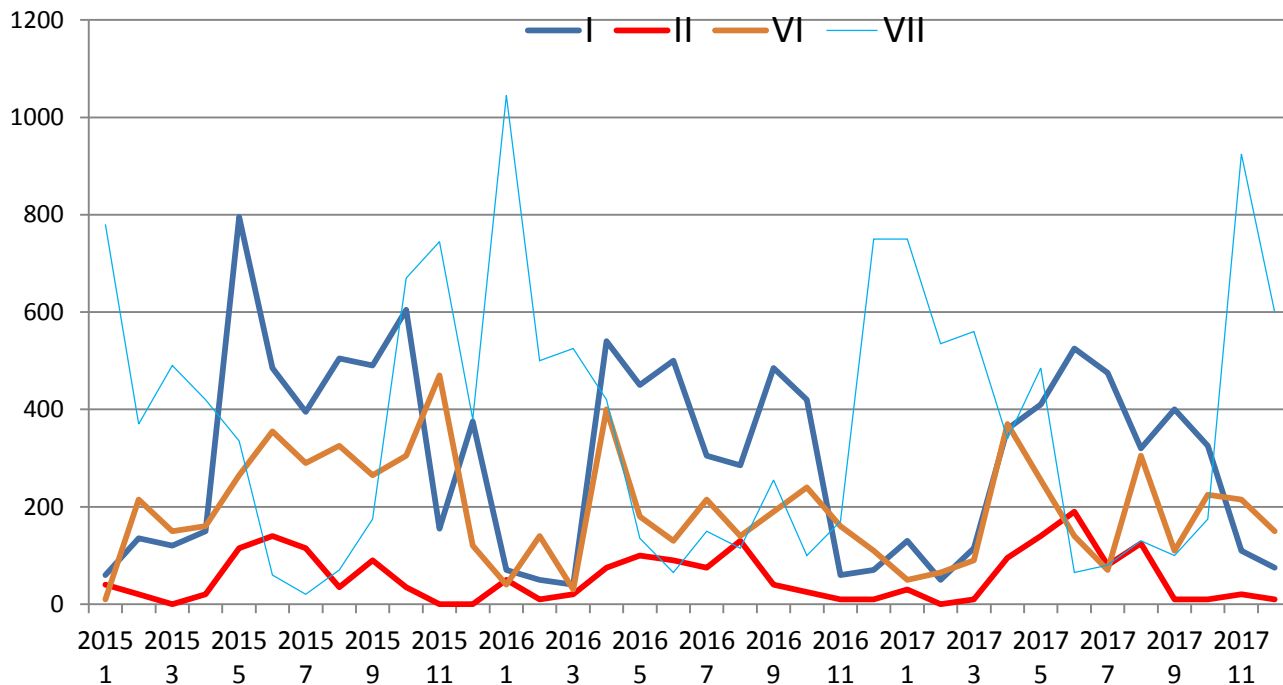

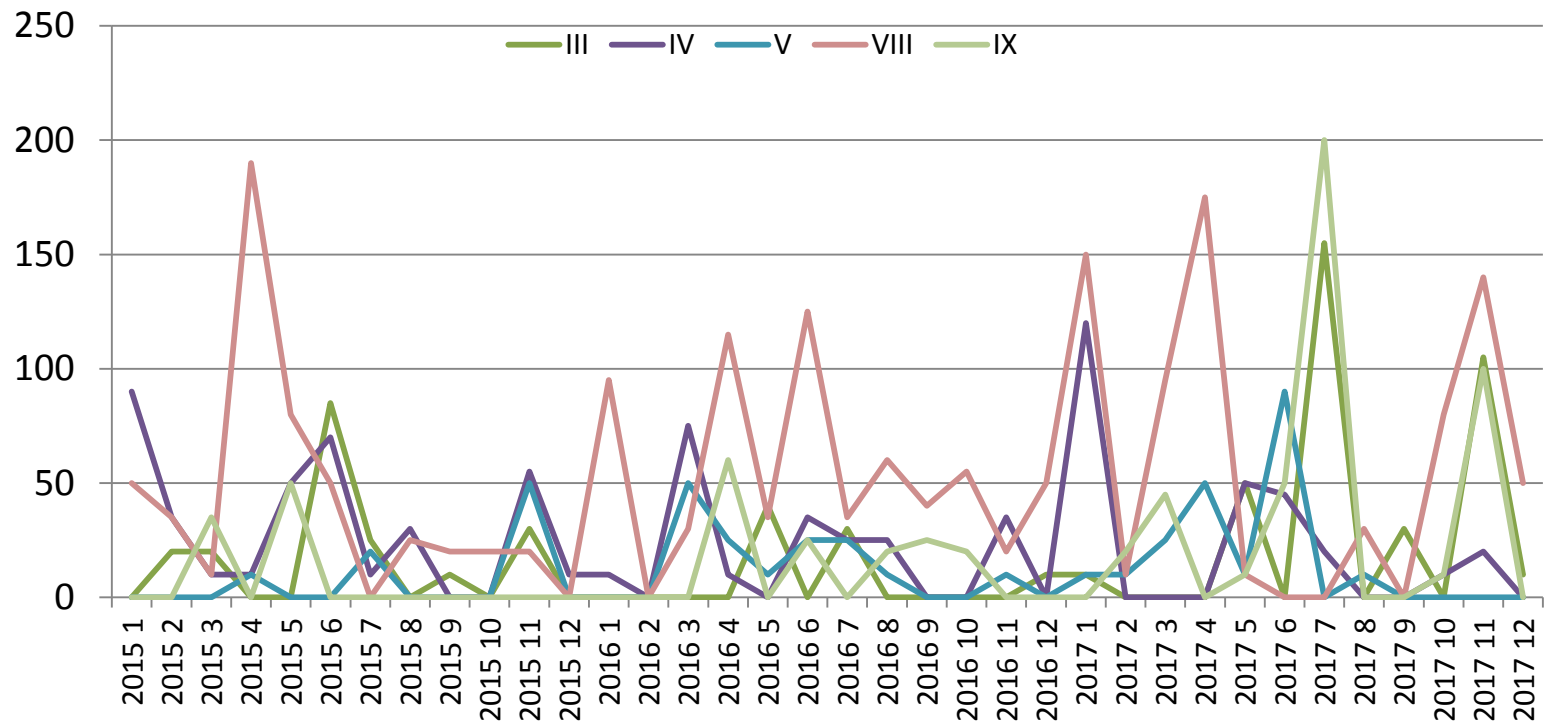

Athletes Penalty Points – Group I, II, VI, VII



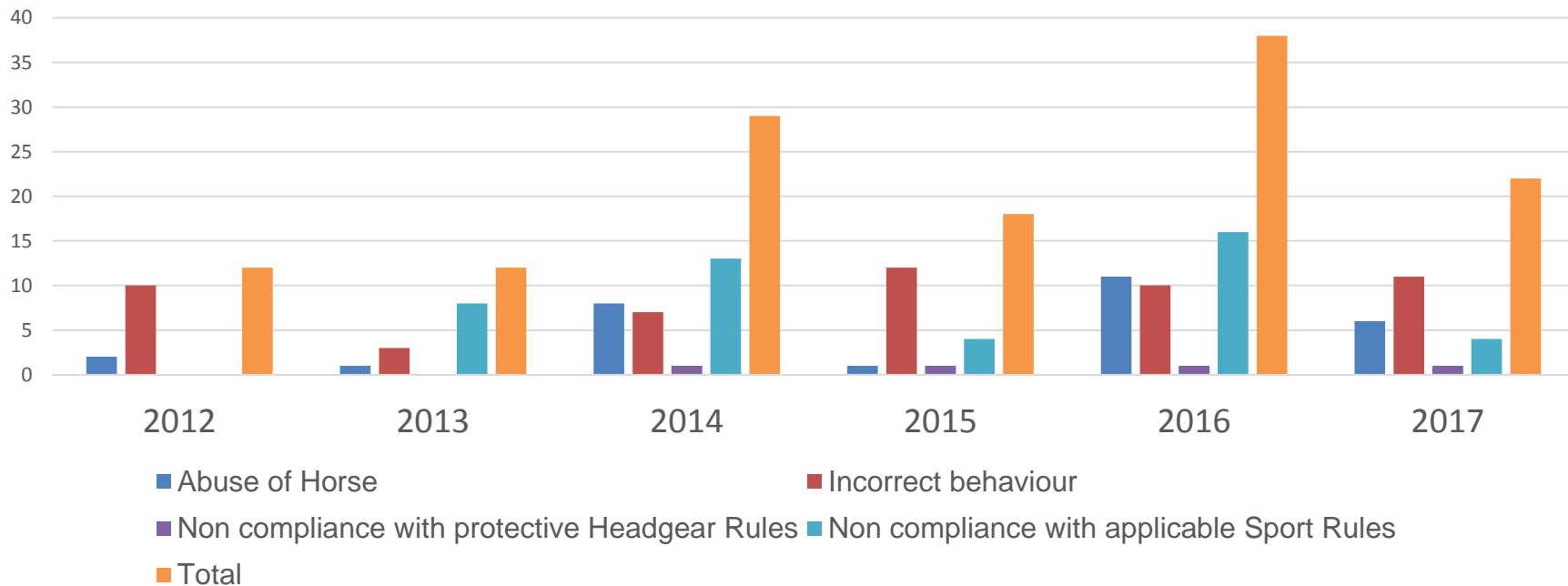

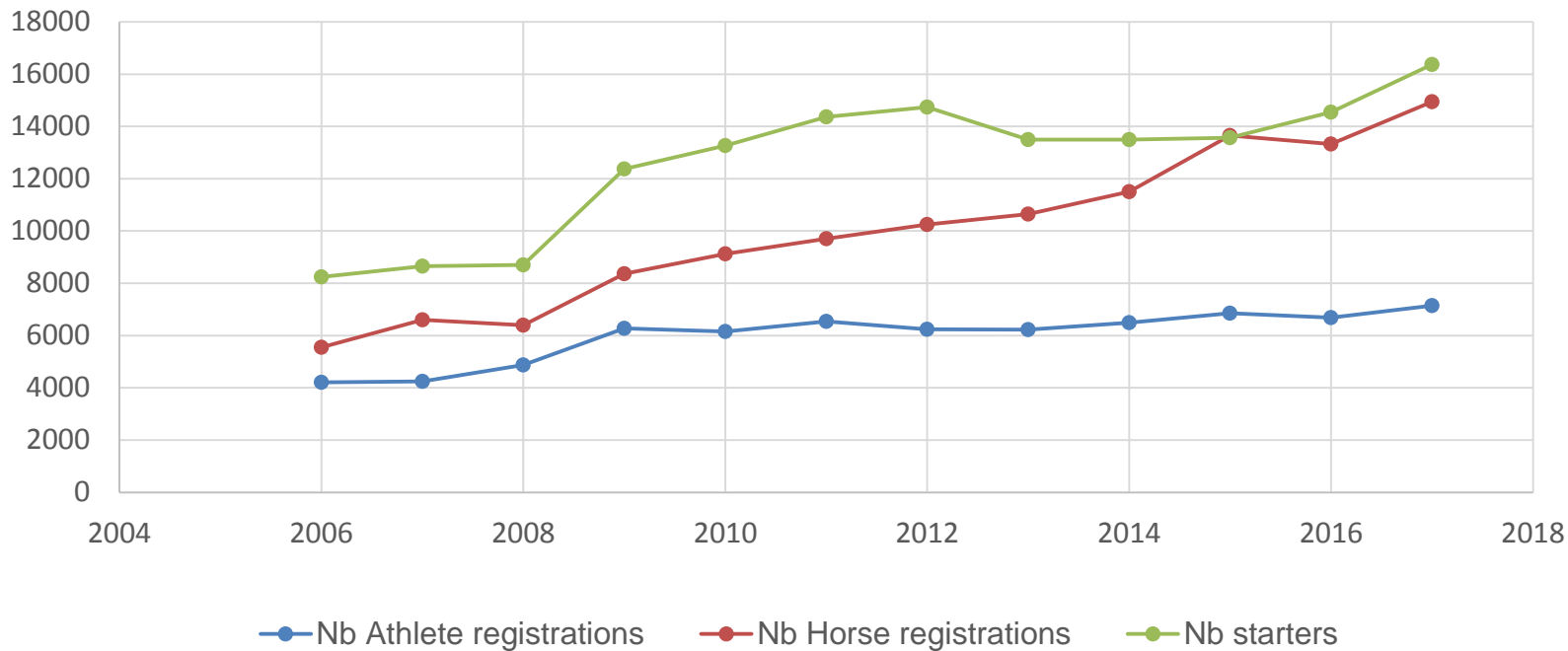
Yellow Cards 2012 - 2017

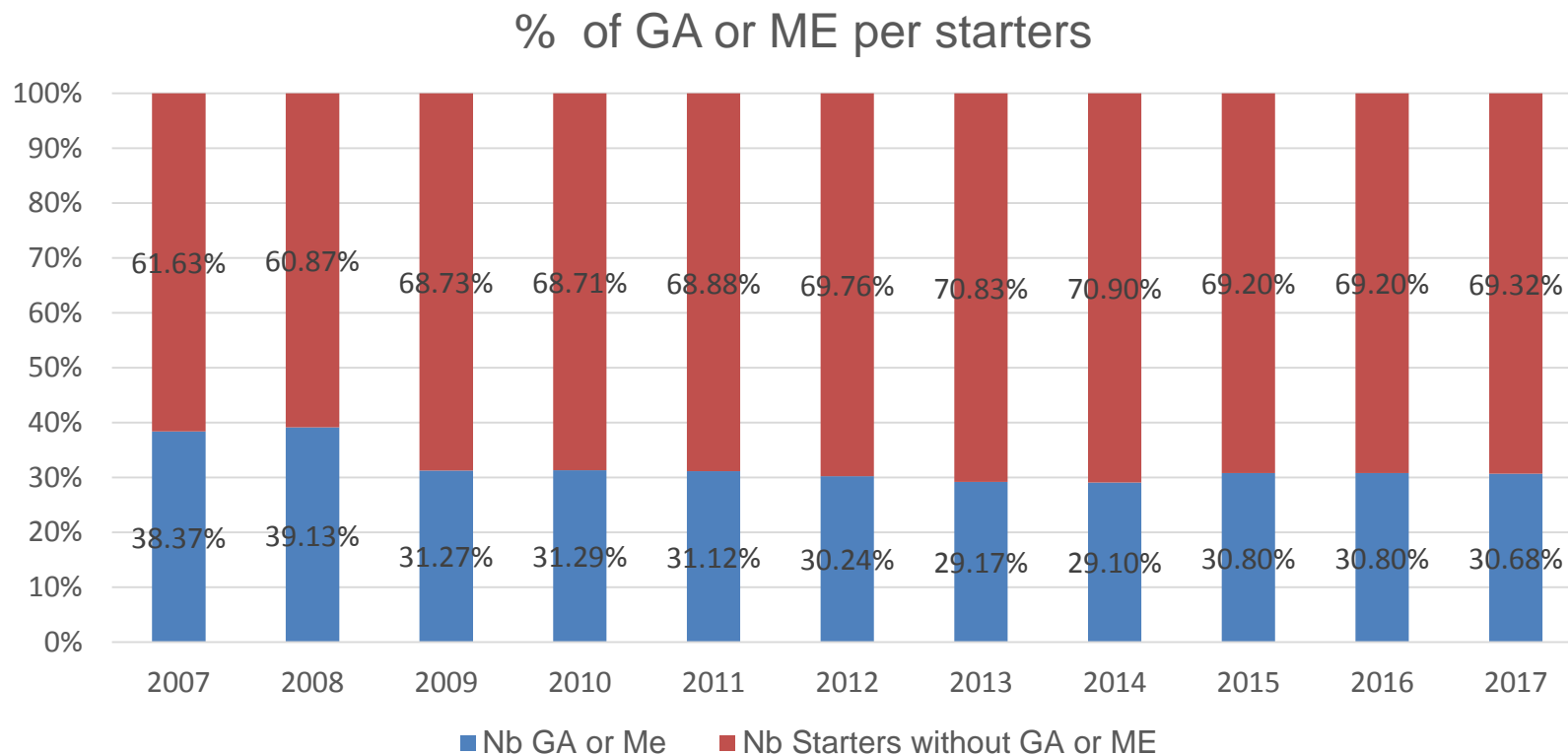

Evolution of Horses / Athletes registration



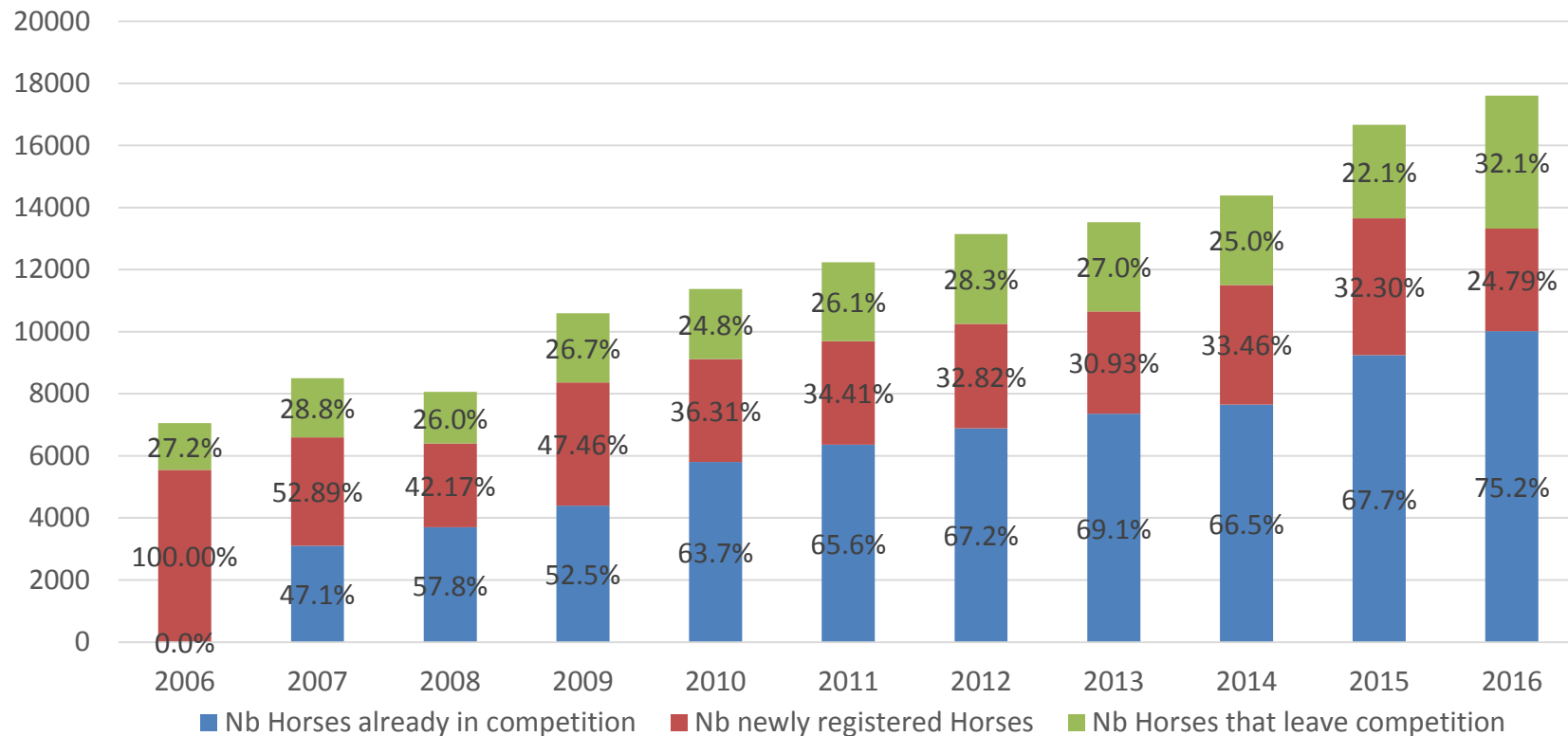

Number of Starters, Irregular Gait (GA) or Metabolic (ME)



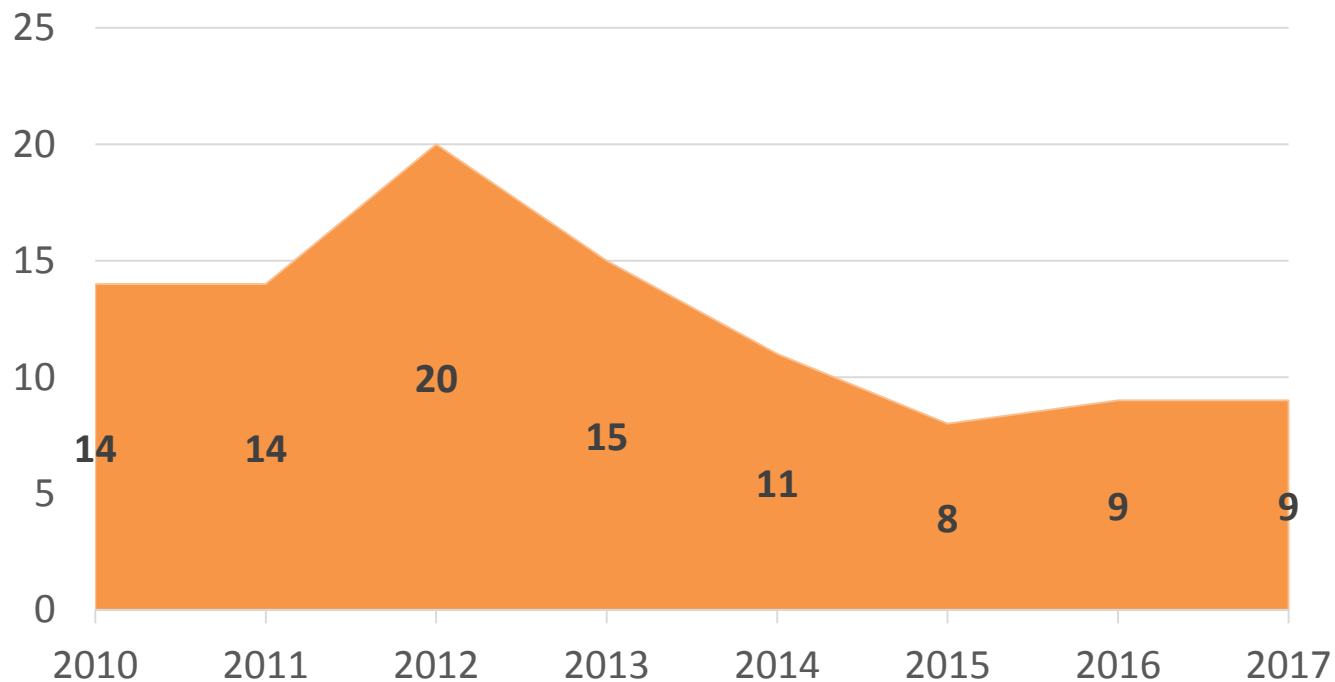

Registered Horses, Horses out of competition, New Horses



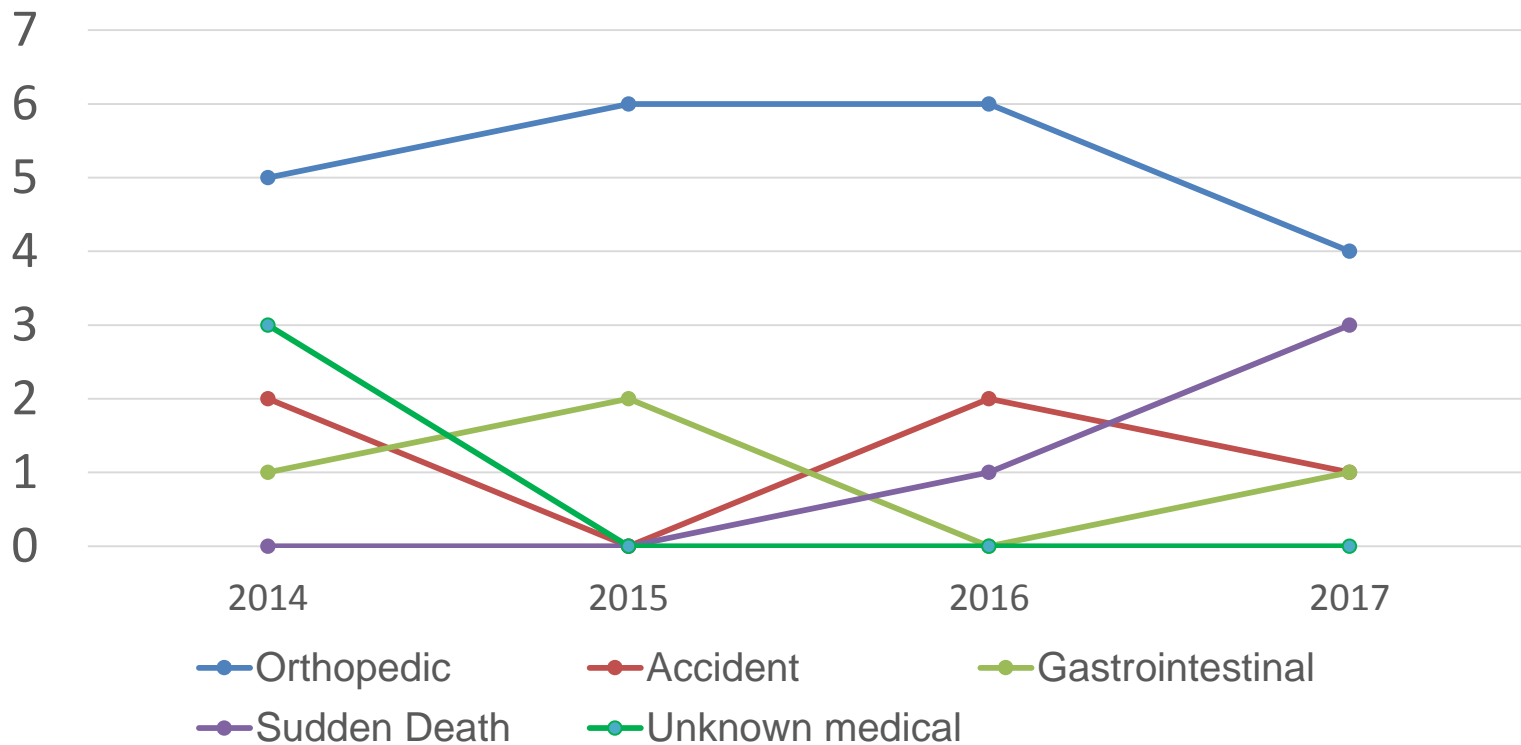

Evolution in different Catastrophic Injuries (CI)

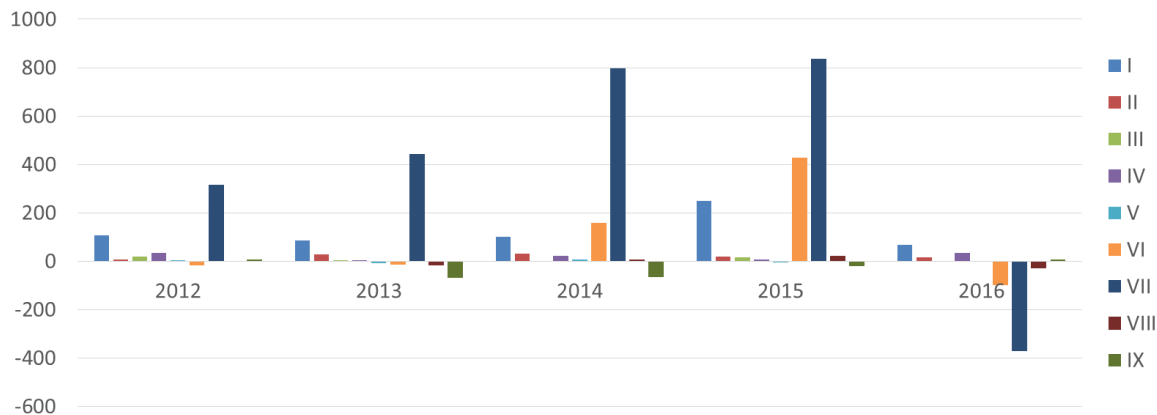

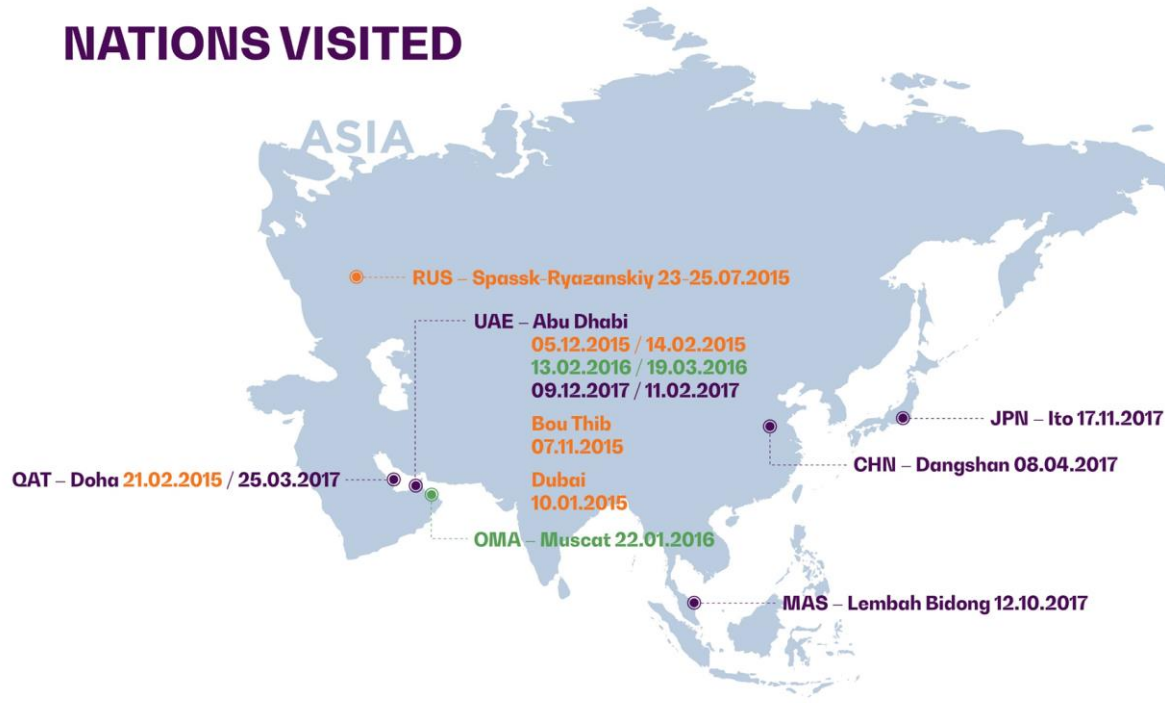

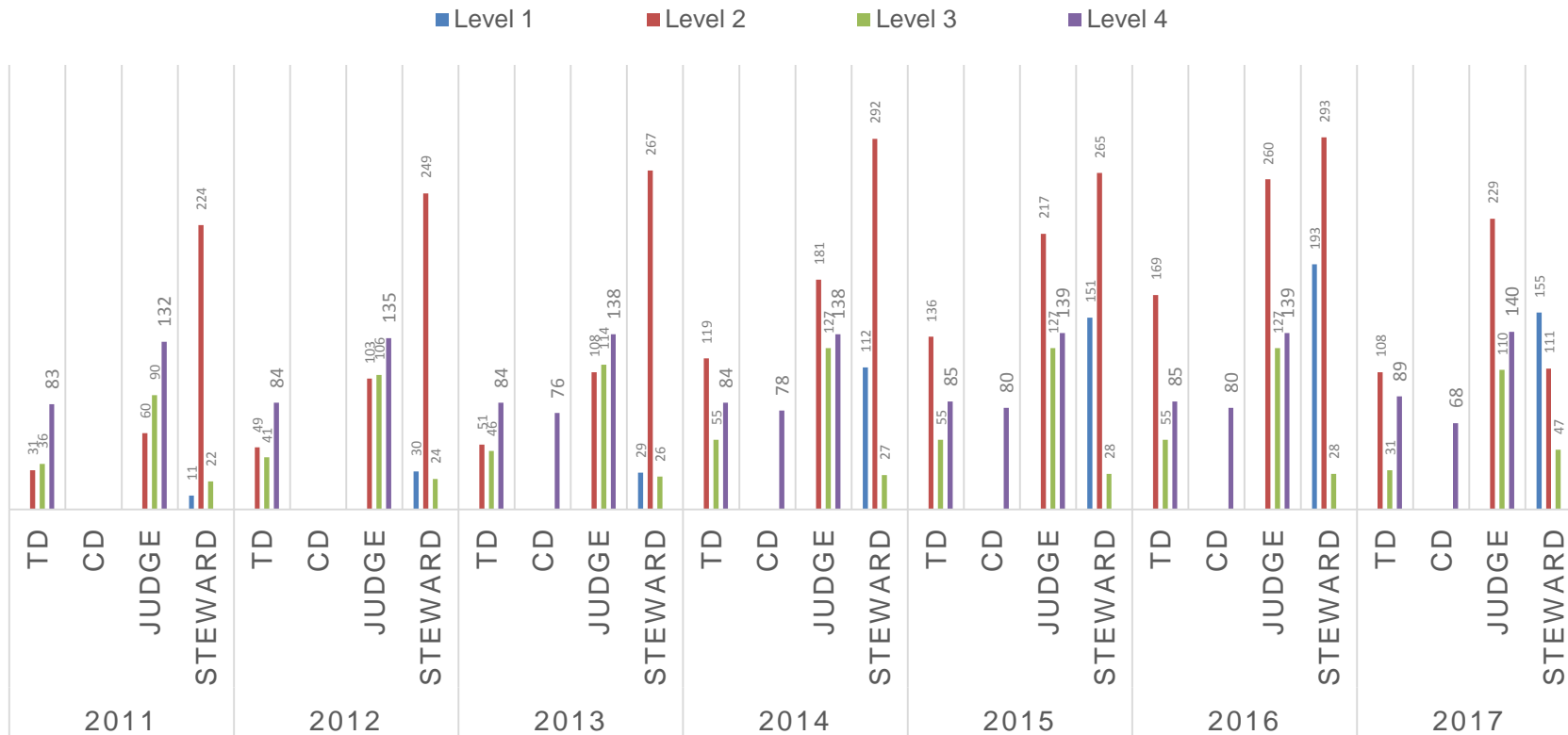

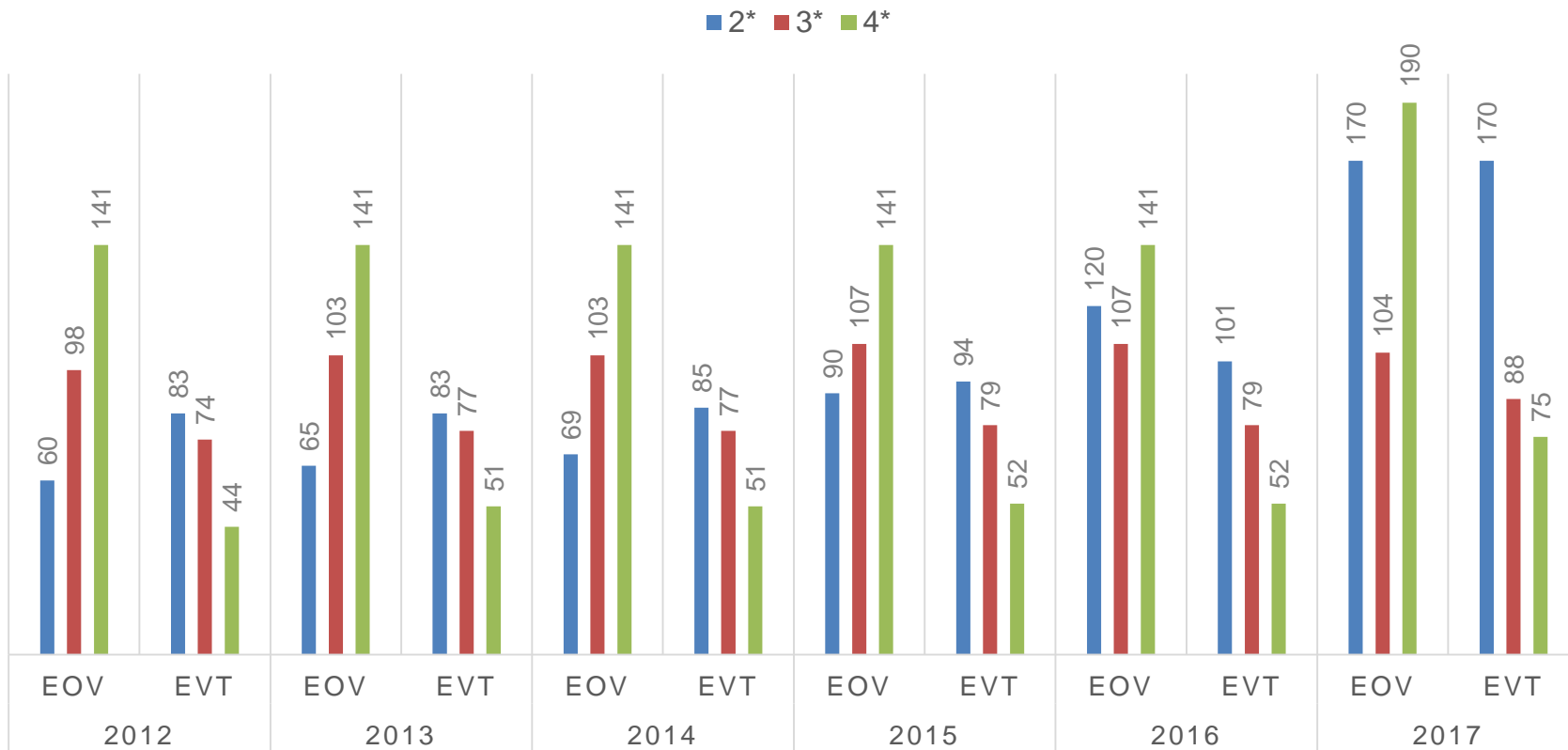

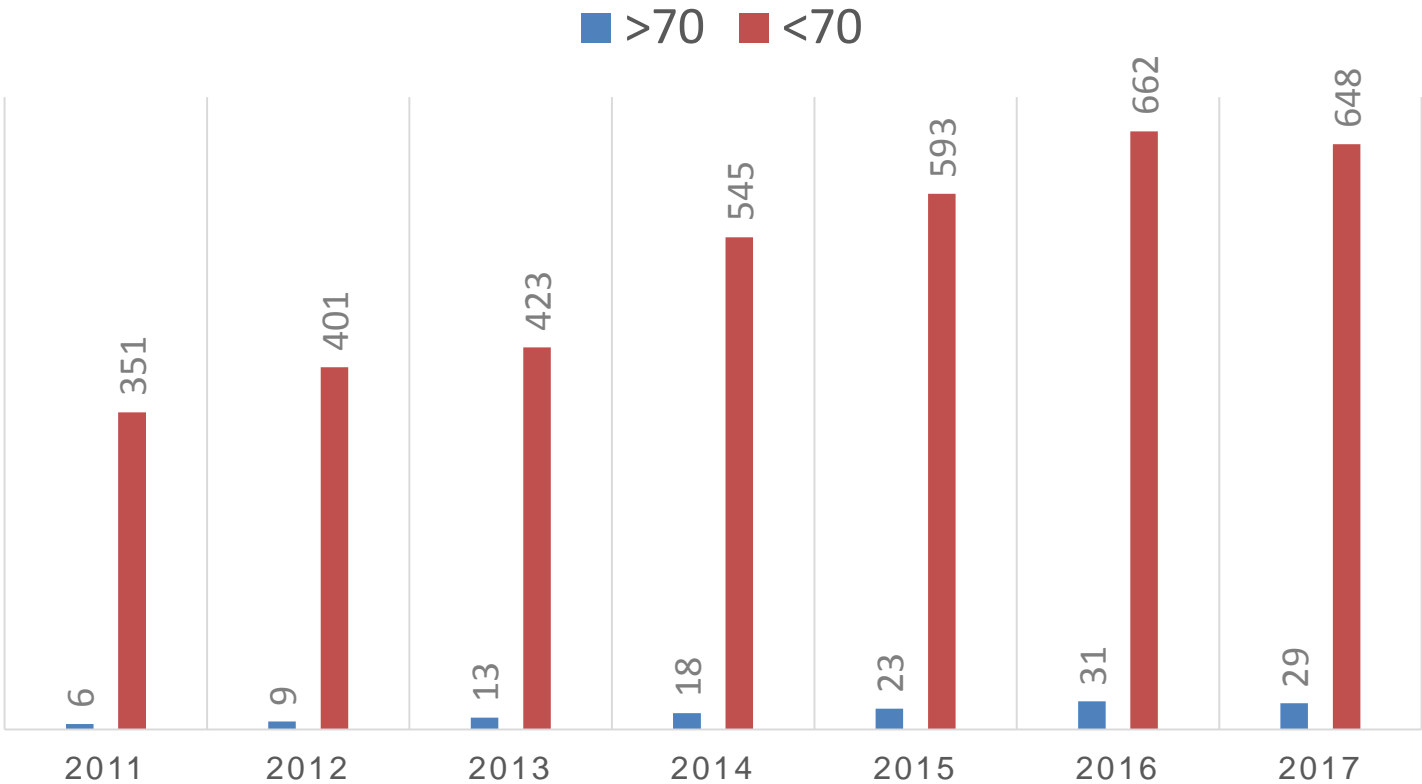
Endurance Officials – Function & Level 2012 – 2017



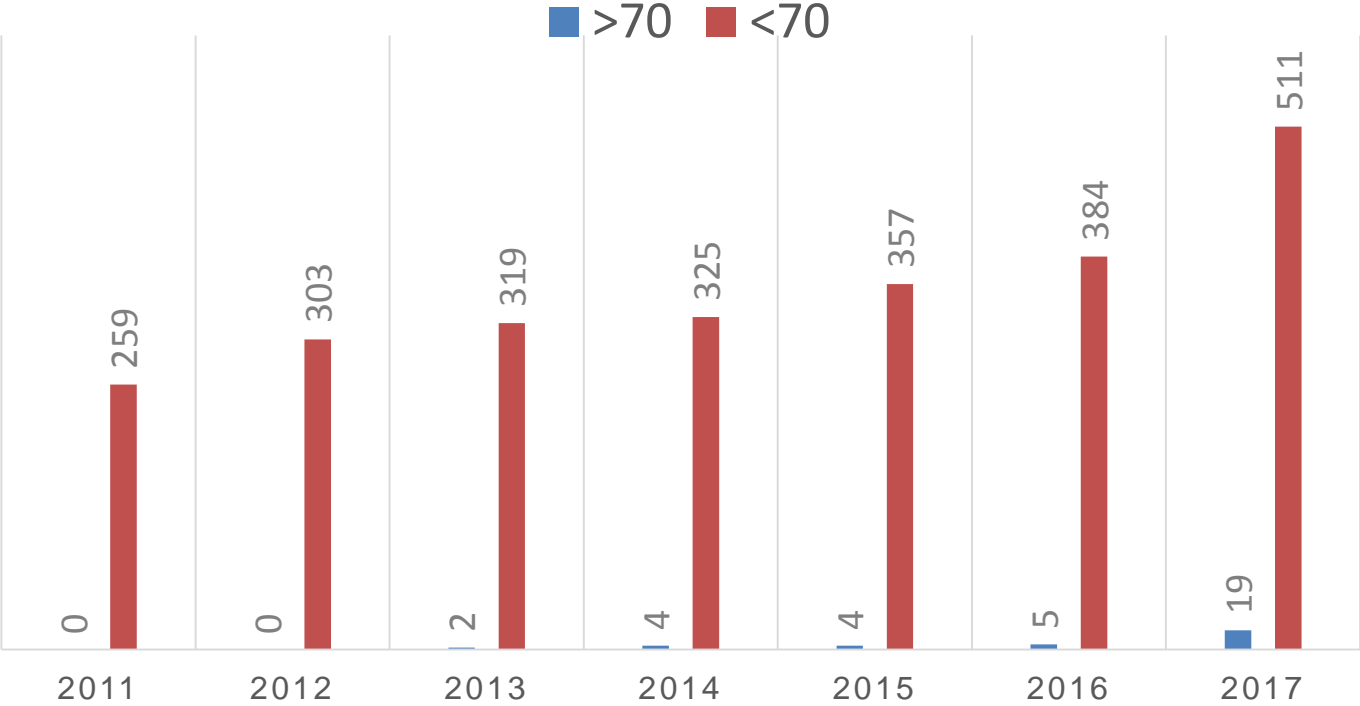
Endurance Officials Vets – Function & Level 2012 – 2017



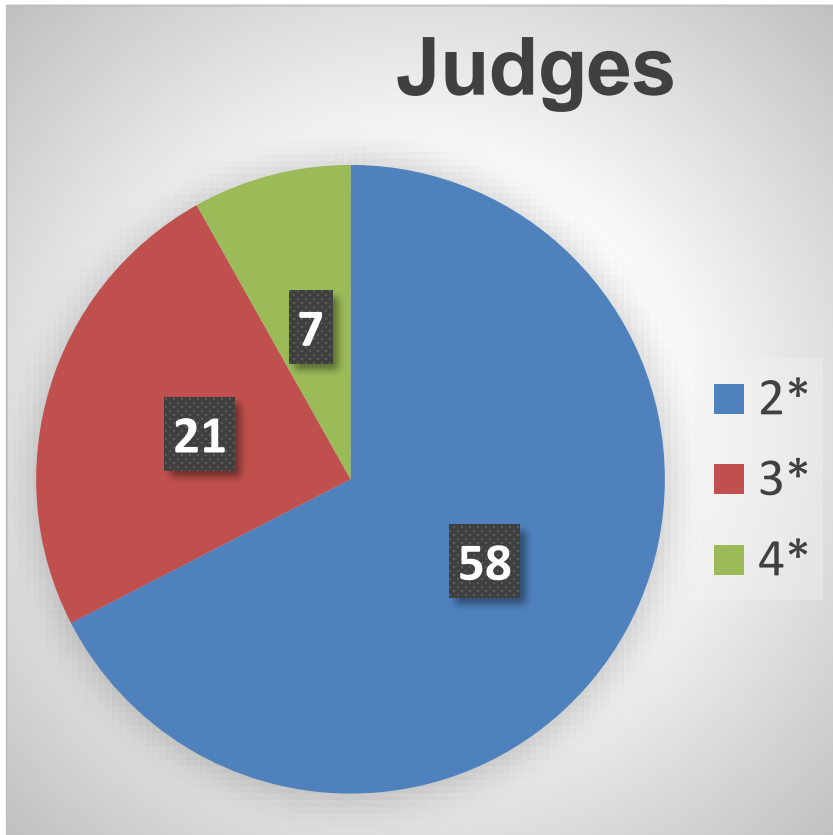
Judges, TDs and Stewards Age > 70 and < 70



Vets Officials Age > 70 and < 70

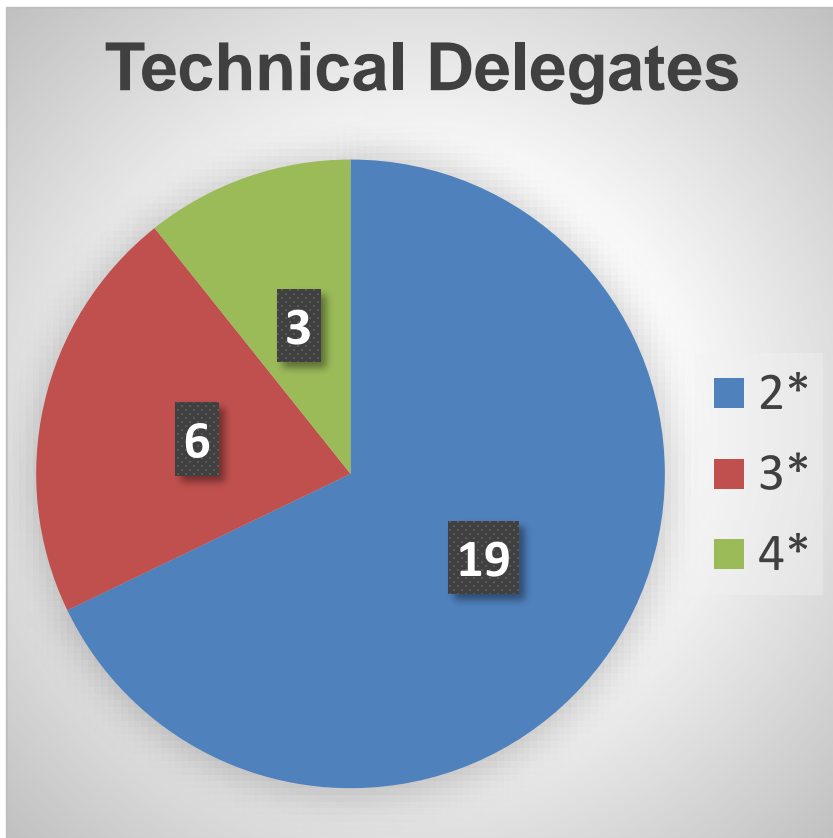


Officials Removed from the list in 2017 due to missing courses



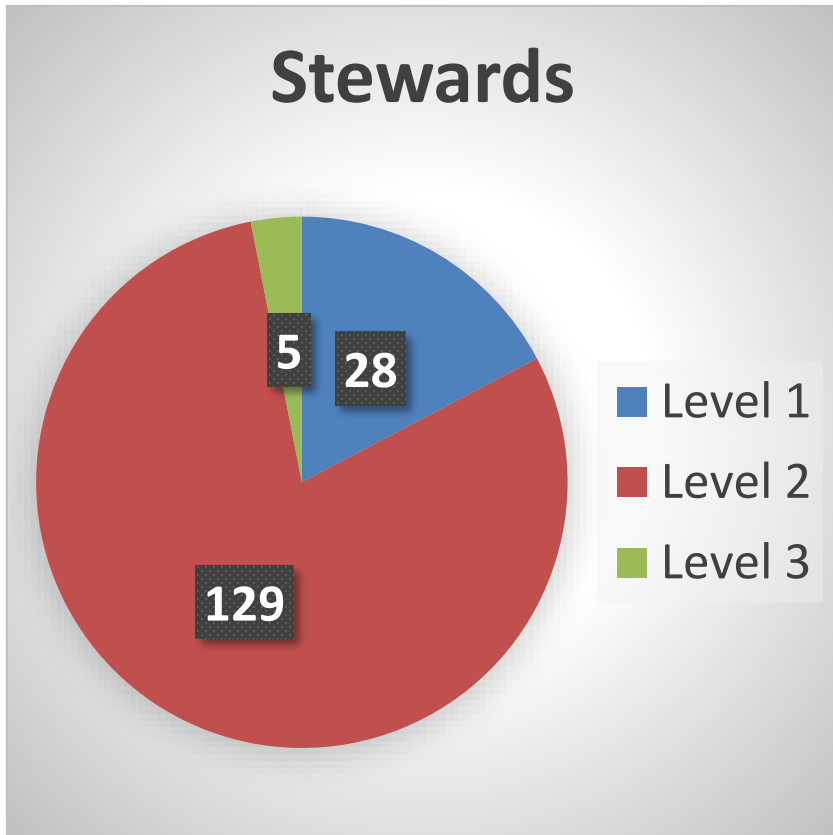
- 86 Judges have been removed from the list, which represent 14% of the total number of active Judges.

Officials Removed from the list in 2017 due to missing courses



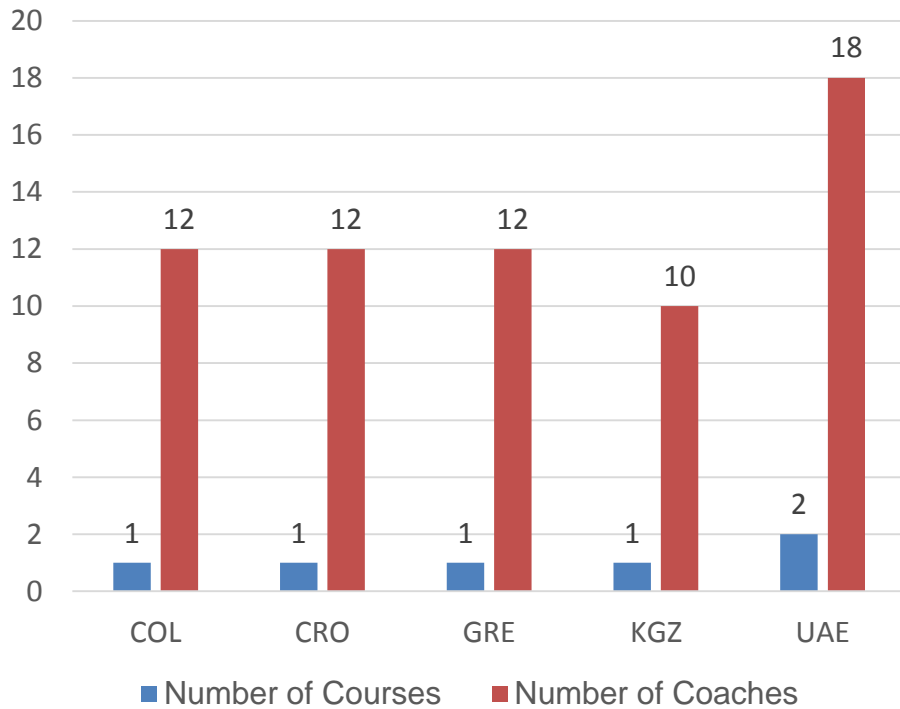
