Ginka Toegel (GER)

IMD Business school professor Ginka Toegel is a teacher, facilitator and researcher in the areas of leadership and human behavior. Specialized in providing one-to-one leadership coaching and team-building workshops to top management teams in both the public and private sector, her major research focuses on leadership development, team dynamics, and coaching. She received the Innovation in Teaching Award at London Business School in 2001 and a Major Review Teaching Prize at the London School of Economics in 2006. Professor Toegel has published articles among others in the Academy of Management Journal, Harvard Business Review, and Sloan Management Review. Prior to commencing her academic career, she worked as a psychotherapist and as a senior manager in a non-profit organisation.
