Caitlin Kraft-Buchman

Caitlin Kraft-Buchman is CEO/Founder of Women@theTable and leads the Geneva based NGO that makes gender visible on the global stage. She is one of three co-founders of International Gender Champions (IGC), a leadership network of female and male decision-makers that break down gender barriers for system change, for which Women@theTable serves as Secretariat.

Ingmar De Vos

FEI President since 2014, Ingmar became a UN International Gender Champion in March 2017. By doing so, he joined heads of sporting bodies, including the IOC, and more than 200 leaders from the diplomatic and international communities and the private sector in taking the International Gender Champions panel parity pledge, all within a network that draws on the United Nations System-wide Action Plan on Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN-SWAP).

Sabrina Ibáñez

Sabrina Ibáñez, former Governance and Executive Affairs Director, became the FEI Secretary General in 2014. She was elected the first President of the Association of Paralympic Sports Organisations (APSO) in 2017 and is also a member of the IOC Gender Equality Working Group.
