ANDALUCÍA SUNSHINE TOUR RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **1.** Sunshine Tour is a Series of competitions organized by CIRCUITO HÍPICO DEL SOL, S.L, located in National Road 340 Km.41.3, 11150 Vejer de la Frontera-Cádiz-Spain.
- 2. The Sunshine Tour starts on week 6 and finishes on week 12 every year.
- **3.** Sunshine Tour is open for competitors of all nations. Rules allowing competitors to participate in the Series are according to the FEI Rules and FEI Official Schedules of CSIYH1*/CSI2*/CSI4* Sunshine Tour every year.
- **4.** Sunshine Tour Series will contain rules for the participation in the "Sunshine Tour Young Horses Finals (five, six and seven years old)" and for the "Sunshine Tour Grand Prix Final". All qualifiers are independent participation in one of the series does not exclude participation in others.

- 1. For every Grand Prix Final, the following six (6) international events of Vejer de la Frontera will count as qualifying events for participation in the "Sunshine Tour Grand Prix Final":
 - a. CSI4* Week 1 of the tour (week 6 on the annual calendar)
 - b. CSI4* Week 2 of the tour (week 7 on the annual calendar)
 - c. CSI4* Week 3 of the tour (week 8 on the annual calendar)
 - d. CSI4* Week 5 of the tour (week 10 on the annual calendar)
 - e. CSI4* Week 6 of the tour (week 11 on the annual calendar)
 - f. CSI4* Week 7 of the tour (week 12 on the annual calendar)

3. Classification rules:

The best (9) nine placed Athletes of each Grand Prix competitions listed in point 2, and the best placed Athletes in competition Big Tour 1.50 of week 7 until the number of 50 starters is reached (Including pre-qualified riders).

The following Athletes (not Athlete/Horse combinations) are automatically qualified for the Grand Prix at CSI Events, if present:

- 261.4.2.1 The winner (Athlete/Horse combination) of that Event's Grand Prix the previous year; according to the following conditions:

 For the Grand Prix at a CSI3*/CSI4*/CSI5* Event, the winner of that Event's Grand Prix the previous year is eligible to participate, providing the previous year's Event was the same star level or a higher star level;
- 261.4.2.2 The current National Jumping Champion (Athlete/Horse combination) of the host country;
- 261.4.2.5 The individual Jumping medal winners of the last Olympic and Pan-American Games, the last World and FEI Continental Championships and the winner of the last FEI World Cup™ Jumping Final.
- **4.** All Athletes qualified for the Grand Prix, including those automatically qualified must complete, with their Grand Prix horse, the initial round of at least one FEI competition among those listed in FEI Jumping Rules Art. 261.4.4 prior to the Grand Prix.
- **5.** Riders are not obliged to take part in every classifying competition class.
- **6.** If a qualified Athlete doesn't start or is already qualified, he will be replaced by the next Athlete from the last qualifying class.
