FEI HYBRID GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2022

The FEI Hybrid General Assembly 2022 will take place on 13 November in Cape Town (RSA) as part of the FEI General Assembly week, which runs from 10-13 November.

IOC YOUNG LEADERS PROGRAMME

Applications are now open for the sixth generation of the IOC Young Leaders programme, supported by Worldwide Olympic Partner Panasonic. The programme aims to support young people in the development and implementation of social projects that use sport to solve issues in their communities.

Any young person aiming to leverage the power of sport to make a positive difference in their community can apply until 20 October 2022 and **register for the compulsory initial four-week Learning Sprint** as the first step in the application process. Once this step is completed, and based on the project idea submitted, 25 IOC Young Leaders will be selected to benefit from a comprehensive four-year programme, providing them with funding, network support, tools and expertise to become successful social entrepreneurs and make a positive impact through sport.

WADA PUBLISHES 2023 PROHIBITED LIST

Human Anti-Doping - WADA Prohibited List 2023

The World Anti-Doping Agency's (WADA) Prohibited List for 2023 is now published [here](#) along with a summary of the major modifications from the 2022 List. It will come into effect on 1 January 2023.

Athletes who take regular medication/medical treatments should recheck it against the 2023 List. In case they take a medication/treatment that has changed status (is now prohibited) they should apply for a **TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)** where necessary. Athletes should run this check with the help of their team doctor, physician and/or their **National /Regional Anti-Doping Organisation**.

Athlete support personnel should ensure they are familiar with the 2023 List and its changes.

Athletes and athlete support personnel should keep in mind that:

- Over-the-counter medication and supplements may contain prohibited substances;
- Supplements may contain prohibited substances that are not declared in the ingredients list on the label. They may also be contaminated with prohibited substances during the manufacturing process.
