Eurosport is a group of pay television networks in Europe and parts of Asia. Owned by Warner Bros. Discovery Sports, a subsidiary of Warner Bros. Discovery, it operates two main channels - Eurosport 1 and Eurosport 2 - across most of its territories, and streams on Discovery+. In 2015, Discovery signed a long-term deal with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) to be the European media rights holder from 2018 until the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

FEI Vaulting Seminar 2022

From 21 -23 October 2022, the Vaulting community turned its focus to the annual in-person FEI Vaulting Seminar held in Rome (ITA).

Not far from 50 participants worldwide met to discuss the recent amendments to the FEI Vaulting Rules and Guidelines 2023 and the future of the Vaulting discipline.

Dedicated sessions to provide participants with important information were held by FEI Director Education & Officials Frank Spadinger on Education, a Legal perspective was provided by FEI Deputy Legal Director Áine Power and a more general update from the FEI was given by FEI Dressage, Para Dressage & Vaulting Director, Bettina de Rham.

The FEI Vaulting Rules had undergone a full revision for the 2022 edition and consequently only few amendments/corrections are recommended for the Vaulting Rules 2023.

The FEI Vaulting Rules 2023 will be submitted for approval at the FEI General Assembly held in Cape Town (RSA) on 13 November 2022, and once approved, they will be published on the **FEI Vaulting Rules page** by the end of November 2022.

SOCIAL MEDIA BEST PRACTICES TAKE CENTRE STAGE AT FEI DIGITAL SEMINARS

Digital seminars for the core equestrian community were held on 11 and 13 October. The objectives were to highlight the best practices in the management and activation of social media platforms to help athletes, National Federations, and equestrian professionals increase their digital audiences and broaden communication.

The first seminar was tailored to the needs of international athletes, grooms, and their support teams whereas the second one was open to National Federations (NFs) Secretary Generals, media managers and individuals within the NFs and Continental Associations involved in communication and/or the management of digital channels. Over 220 attendees took part in the seminars. The participants were pleased with the quality of information and exchanges provided.

LATEST NEWS ON THE FEI SOLIDARITY RELIEF FUND FOR UKRAINE

Following the invasion of Ukraine by Russian military forces on 24 February, the FEI set aside a CHF 1 Million Solidarity Relief Fund to aid the equestrian community in the country as well as those who have left the embattled nation. In the months that followed, the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) also joined forces with the FEI Solidarity Relief Fund, establishing the USEF Ukraine Relief Fund to support Ukraine horses and equestrians, with 100% of funds raised going to the FEI Solidarity Relief Fund to be distributed by the FEI for projects approved by the USEF.

Support to the equestrian community in Ukraine has been ongoing since February and through the summer months. Working closely with the Ukrainian Equestrian Federation

Charity Foundation (UEF-CF), the FEI Solidarity Relief Fund has established a number of programmes and activations with the help of the Charity Foundation providing invaluable insights and logistical support on the ground.

Aid has been provided in the relocation of horses from conflict zones.

The fund supplied athlete scholarships and provided training support for young athletes, who took part in this summer's FEI Dressage European Championships for Juniors and Young Riders held in Hartpury (GBR).

Assistance was provided to five young Vaulting Athletes who became the first team to ever represent Ukraine in international Vaulting Event when they participated in CVI1* in Kaposvár (HUN) from 20 to 22 May.

The team's participation in Kaposvár came just a few short months after fleeing their hometown of Poltava in central Ukraine to escape the war. They stayed and trained in Bernolákovo, a suburb of Bratislava (SVK), where they were welcomed wholeheartedly by members of the local Vaulting community.

Another noteworthy initiative was the purchase of equine medicines and veterinary supplies for distribution to Ukrainian veterinarians. The most needed medications and supplies worth USD 100,000 were commissioned in Europe and delivered to a warehouse in Poland. From there, they were dispatched to Ukraine, where the UEF-CF coordinated further transportation and delivery.

Some 7,400 kg of veterinary supplies were distributed with the help of 22 veterinarians throughout Ukraine to treat common conditions such as colic, infections, and lameness for 5,700 horses.

Help in key areas has been provided, but the needs are dire as the situation on the ground has worsened since February.
