Comments to 2024 FEI revised budget

(all numbers in '000 CHF unless otherwise specified)

Dear President, Members of the Board, Secretary General,

At the end of 2023, we presented a 2024 budget with a deficit of -391. This result highlighted the need to analyze our spending and revenue based on FEI strategic priorities. Our first conclusion has shown that the operating revenues do not cover FEI cost structure. On one hand, the FEI has invested and grown over the years, providing additional support and services. Moreover, the cost base was significantly hit by the post-COVID inflation. On the other hand, the financial charges have remained unchanged.

During this review, we have decided to challenge our expenses and prioritize our projects for 2024 resulting in a net cost adjustment of -391, bringing the revised budget to a neutral net result. Please find here below the explanations and details:

• Total non-operational revenues

 Contribution from funds: Additional budget of +1'900 was approved, at February Executive Board meeting, to support the digital campaign for Paris. This extra budget, as well as, additional spending of +55 for the Olympics will be funded by the Olympic fund and will have no impact on 2024 results.

• Total commercial expenses

 Marketing (branding) and digital expenses revised upwards by +89 due to additional costs related to the LLN.

• Total operational expenses

- Anti-doping and welfare budget adjusted downwards by -225 to 3,785.
- Professional fee/consulting reduced by -185, main actions on Technology & Sport Services with the prioritization of projects.
- Higher education costs +11 (related to the Olympics) which will be compensated by the Olympic fund, as mentioned above.

Total General & Administrative expenses

- Special projects with higher costs +1872 are mainly related to the additional budget of +1,900 linked to the Olympic campaign and financed by the Olympic fund, as mentioned above. The difference of -28 is driven by lower cost from the Legal department budget (Concussion project).
- Trophies & medals +44, related to Paris 2024 and also compensated by the Olympic fund.
- Travel expenses budget revised downwards by -42 to 1'905 (FEI employees and officials).

The current market environment is at the moment favorable with inflation levels stabilizing, recession avoided in EU and expected decrease of interest rates under discussions. Our portfolio is currently benefiting with a year-to-date April profit of 1,726. Nevertheless, due to geo-politic tensions and uncertainty effects around US elections, we recommend to take a conservative approach and keep the financial revenues budget unchanged.
