
Dear National Federations,

**A. PROPOSED RULES CHANGES TO BE VOTED AT THE FEI GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2022**

<b>Explanation for Proposed Change</b>			
<b>No rule change proposed</b> same Ranking rules as for the Tokyo2020 Olympic Games, (only date and location updates of the 2023 Championships).			
<b>Proposed Wording on 6 July 2022</b>			
<b>FEI OLYMPIC ATHLETES/HORSES COMBINATIONS RANKINGS - EVENTING</b>			
<p>The point system to be used for establishing the FEI Olympic Athletes Rankings - Eventing is based on Athletes/Horses combinations achieving FEI Qualifying Results (MER) in CCI4* &amp; 5* events (CCI4* Long &amp; Short) between the period from <b>1 January – 31 December 2023</b>.</p> <p>Points are allocated to the top 25% of starters (based on the Dressage test) as per current point system:</p> <p>For the Olympic Qualification (as approved by the IOC), the Olympic Ranking list would be based on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Four (4)</b> best results per Athlete/Horse combination</li> <li>- Ranking list covers the period from <b>1 January – 31 December 2023</b></li> <li>- Only events <b>CCI 4*-L &amp; CCI 4*-S &amp; up</b> (see list on Paris 2024 Olympic Games web-site to be published in December 2022) count for Athlete/Horse combinations to obtain Olympic Eligibility.</li> <li>- Only Minimum Eligibility Requirements results count for the FEI Olympic rankings.</li> <li>- Athlete/Horse combinations competing at events with Continental Championship 4* status counting for the Olympic Team Qualification: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o 2023 CH-EU-C Pin du Haras (FRA)</li> <li>o Olympic Group C, F&amp;G 2023 Designated Olympic Qualification Event will receive points as for CH-CCI4* (111 points allocated to 1<sup>st</sup> place)</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>*Note:</b> Olympic Ranking points for the Group C designated event will be awarded as for a CH-CCI4* (111, 106, 102) to Group C Athlete/horse combinations completing the Team competition</p> <p>Athlete/Horse combinations participating in the Individual competition will be allocated points as per the level of the event as for a CCI(O)4*-L, (71,67,64...)</p>			
<b>Placing of Rider</b>	<b>CHs 4*-L CCI 5*-L</b>	<b>CCI(O) 4*-L</b>	<b>CCI(O) 4*-S</b>

Each Athlete finishing the Event out of the top 25% but with a MER will receive the same number of points as per the below

**TIE BREAK PROCEDURE:**  
 In the case of a tie in Olympic Ranking points, the tie break procedure principle of the FEI World Eventing Athletes Rankings will apply. Accordingly, the best placing at the highest level event will decide. If there is still a tie, the second best result of each combination has to be compared and so on until the fourth result is compared. The level of competition is defined according to the above table and not the star level.
