Although all too brief, Marco's time at FEI Headquarters nonetheless left an indelible legacy and he will be remembered by all of us with respect and affection. I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to the Jumping Department staff, and particularly Paule Gerritsen, for stepping up in very difficult circumstances in order keep the Jumping Department running seamlessly.

In order to sustain and build on already-established good working relationships, there were informal telephone calls or meetings with other Stakeholders.

2.3 Revision of the FEI Jumping Rules

After the full FEI Jumping Rules Revision in 2021 of the 2022 Jumping Rules, only a few minor changes were proposed to and approved by the FEI GA in Cape Town (RSA) in November 2022.

2.4 FEI Jumping EU-CH and Continental Games for Seniors 2023

2023 was a rich year for Jumping Championships and Games.

The EU-CH for Seniors was held in Milan (ITA) in late August and early September. A sell-out crowd enjoyed top sport over the 5 days of competition, which also saw teams battling for three available 2024 Olympic slots.

The 2022 Asian Games, delayed by one year as a consequence of the global pandemic, took place in October in Hangzhou (CHN).

The 2023 Pan-Am Games take place in Santiago (CHI) in late October and early November, and the remaining regional team slots for Paris 2024 will be fiercely contested.

2.5 Longines FEI Jumping World Cup[™]

After two seasons of cancellations and/or disruption, the 2022-2023 Longines FEI Jumping World Cup^{TM} season ran worldwide with no issues. The series continues to be popular with all stakeholders and produces excellent sport.

For the second time in 6 years, Omaha (USA) hosted the Longines FEI World Cup[™] Finals as a multi-discipline (Jumping, Dressage and Vaulting) event.

2.6 Longines FEI Jumping Nations Cup[™]

All scheduled 2023 Longines FEI Nations Cup[™] events took place.

In late September and early October, the 2023 Longines FEI Jumping Nations Cup[™] Final, where one 2024 Olympic Games team qualifying slot was available, ran in Barcelona (ESP), and was a huge success.

Following several online and in-person meetings with all relevant stakeholders, the FEI finalised the plans for a long-awaited innovative concept – the FEI Longines League of NationsTM – that will see the introduction in 2024 of a truly international series for the best 10 teams selected from a worldwide pool.

I would like to thank everyone involved for their invaluable contribution in the developmental stages, and in particular our Top Partner, Longines, for their strong support of this new series.

2.7 Longines Ranking Working Group

In 2023, the Longines Ranking Working Group held two meetings to discuss ranking-related issues:

2.8 **FEI Jumping Officials**

2.8.1 Appointment of Officials

In accordance with confirmed dates and venues, the FEI JC appointed the Officials for most of the 2024 Championships, Games and Finals.

2.8.2 Education of Jumping Officials

The fourth FEI Course for Transfer-Up to, and Confirmation of, Level 4 Jumping Judges that began in the summer of 2023 with an online phase will be finalised in November 2023. All previously-listed L4 Judges who chose to do so are now in compliance with the Confirmation procedure.

The third FEI Course for Transfer-Up to L4 Jumping Stewards that began in July 2023 with an online phase will also be finalised in November 2023.

The first FEI Pilot Virtual In-Person Maintenance Course for Jumping Judges was run in early November. A similar project will also run for Jumping Stewards later in the same month.

Throughout the year, FEI Course Directors ran multiple In-Person Maintenance and Transfer-Up Courses for Judges, Stewards and Course Designers across the world.

2.9 FEI JC Members and Elections

The two new FEI JC Members Rodrigo Pessoa (BRA) as Athlete's Representative and Michael Stone (IRL) have integrated fully into the FEI JC.

On completion of his four-year term after the 2023 FEI GA, Henrik Ankarcrona (SWE) will leave the FEI JC and will be replaced by a candidate TBC by the FEI Board.

2.10 Miscellaneous

As always, the FEI Jumping Committee made recommendations on important aspects of the sport, such as suggesting items for inclusion in the FEI Tack, Equipment and Dress Database, and FEI TackApp, as well as rules for FEI-approved series.
