Veterinary Covid-19 guidelines

The FEI Covid-19 policy has been updated with stronger recommendations on the use of masks. The Policy now “strongly recommends that face masks are worn by all persons on the venue at FEI Events, except:

- When mounted on a horse or driving a carriage; and,
- For athletes and Driving Grooms, while training and competing”.

This means that we no longer recommend that masks are used “whenever there is a doubt that social distancing can be maintained”. We now strongly recommend that masks are used at all times, except in the situations mentioned above.
