

## Athletes/Horses automatically qualified for the Grand Prix Competition at CSI Events 2024

If qualification conditions for Athletes are scheduled for the Grand Prix at a CSI Event, it is compulsory that the formula given below is referred to. This does not apply to CSI Events that are part of a Series approved by the FEI Board.

In accordance with Article 261.4.2 of the Jumping Rules, the following are **automatically** qualified for the Grand Prix Competition at CSI Events, if present:

### Art. 261.4.2.1

- For the Grand Prix at a CSI3\*/CSI4\*/CSI5\* Event, the winner (Athlete/Horse combination) of that Event's Grand Prix the previous year is eligible to participate, providing the previous year's Event was the same star level or a higher star level.

### Art. 261.4.2.2

- The current National Jumping Champion (Athlete/Horse combination) of the host country.

### Art. 261.4.2.3

The individual Jumping medal winners of the last Olympic and Pan-American Games, the last World and Continental\* Championships (\*provided the competitions at the Continental Championship were conducted in accordance with the competition format and at the maximum height of obstacles established in Articles 323 through 327 of the Rules for Jumping Championships and Games) and the winner of the last FEI Jumping World Cup™ Final.
