
1. HIGHLIGHTS 2024

- Measures related to Equine Anti-Doping (50) still represent the biggest bulk (72.7%) of total cases handled by the FEI Tribunal (68).
- Decrease in number of cases handled under the concept of "Consent Award". In total 30 Consent Awards approved by the FEI Tribunal (44 cases during 2023), representing 60%, of the total 50 Equine Antidoping Cases and 44.12% of total cases handled.
- Up to date with ongoing cases. No pending case from previous year (i.e. 2023).
- Increased role of the FEI Tribunal as appeal instance: 3 cases during 2023 vs 13 during 2024.




2. FEI TRIBUNAL DECISIONS 2024 - a. Equine Positives

Equine Positives: 50 Sanctions (12 Banned Substances, 38 Controlled Medications)

50 Sanctions (48 Decisions)

- **3** Cases resulted in no Sanction due to No Fault/Negligence findings.
- 2 Final Suspension of 30 Months (1 PRs & 1 Trainer)
- 1 Final Suspension of 27 Months (Trainer)
- 1 Final Suspension of 24 Months (Trainer)
- 3 Final Suspension of 18 Months (2 PRs & 1 Trainer)
- 3 Final Suspension of 12 Months (2 PRs & 1 Trainer)
- **3** Final Suspension of 6 Months (1 PR & 2 Trainers)
- **3** Final Suspension of 4 Months (1 PR & 2 Trainers)
- **26** Final Suspension of 3 Months (9 PRs & 17 Trainers)
- **3** Final Suspension of 2 Months (3 PRs)
- 2 Final Suspension of 1 Month (1 PR & 1 Trainer)





2. FEI TRIBUNAL DECISIONS 2024 - a. Equine Positives



Average Suspension 2024 -> **6.34 Months**

- 13.67 Months for Banned Substances
- 4.03 Months for Controlled Medications (2023 -> 7.04 Months; 2022 -> 6.75 Months)

Average fine 2024 -> CHF 2'784


- CHF 4167 for Banned Substances
- CHF 2'347 for Controlled Medications (2023-> CHF 2'736; 2022 -> CHF 2'713)
