

GUIDELINES ON THE PUBLISHING OF DRESSAGE RESULTS ON

ELECTRONIC SCORE BOARDS (updated 28 January 2013)

5 JUDGES & HALF MARKS

Basic Rules:

- "After each performance the percentage awarded by each judge will be published separately and provisionally in addition to the general total (FEI Rules for Dressage Events 24th Edition; Art. 435.1)."
- "All results must be published in percentages with numbers to 3 places after the decimal point (FEI Rules for Dressage Events 24th Edition; Art. 435.3)."
- "No scoring should be visible to the judges during a test. Solutions to show a running score (total average percentage) and open scoring (average marks per movement for all judges) to the audience are encouraged. (FEI Rules for Dressage Events 24th Edition; Art. 435.6)."
- After the result per judge there should be shown the ranking of that rider for each judge (in the below illustration this is shown as (1), (3), (1), etc.)
- In order to reduce the text of the Dressage movements on the score boards to a minimum, the FEI has attached an Annex I to this document which shows appropriate abbreviations for the movements in a Grand Prix and Grand Prix Special test.


1. Big Score Boards

1.1 Display of total results for the standard competitions (such as Grand Prix, Grand Prix Special) after the rider has finished his/her test and <u>all</u> the judges have submitted their results



1.2 Display of total results for Freestyle competitions (such as the Grand Prix Freestyle) after the rider has finished his/her test and <u>all</u> the judges have submitted their results



If such a display of the total results as shown above is not possible spacewise, the following option may be used instead (which only shows the percentage awarded by each judge as the average of the technical and artistic marks as well as the general total of all judges):






- 1.3 Display of the Running Average Percentage for the standard competitions (such as Grand Prix, Grand Prix Special) while the rider is riding his/her test. The Running Percentage can only be shown until that movement for which <u>all</u> the judges have submitted their marks.
 - 1.3.1 In case of <u>no</u> small score boards being used (where the running percentage could be displayed to the spectators), the following display on the big score board is recommended:

1.3.2 In case of small score boards being used (where the running percentage is displayed to the spectators), the following display on the big score board is recommended:





2. Small Score Boards

(not visible for the rider and judges in the arena)

2.1. Display of total results for the standard AND Freestyle competitions after the rider has finished his/her test and <u>all</u> the judges have submitted their results

2.2. Display of Open Scoring and Running Score for the standard competitions (such as Grand Prix, Grand Prix Special) while the rider is riding his/her test. The marks of the Open Scoring as well as the Running Score can only be shown until that movement for which <u>all</u> the judges have submitted their marks.



2.3. Due to the nature of the judging of Freestyle tests, an Open Scoring is not possible for any Freestyle competition.
