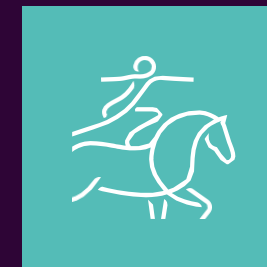

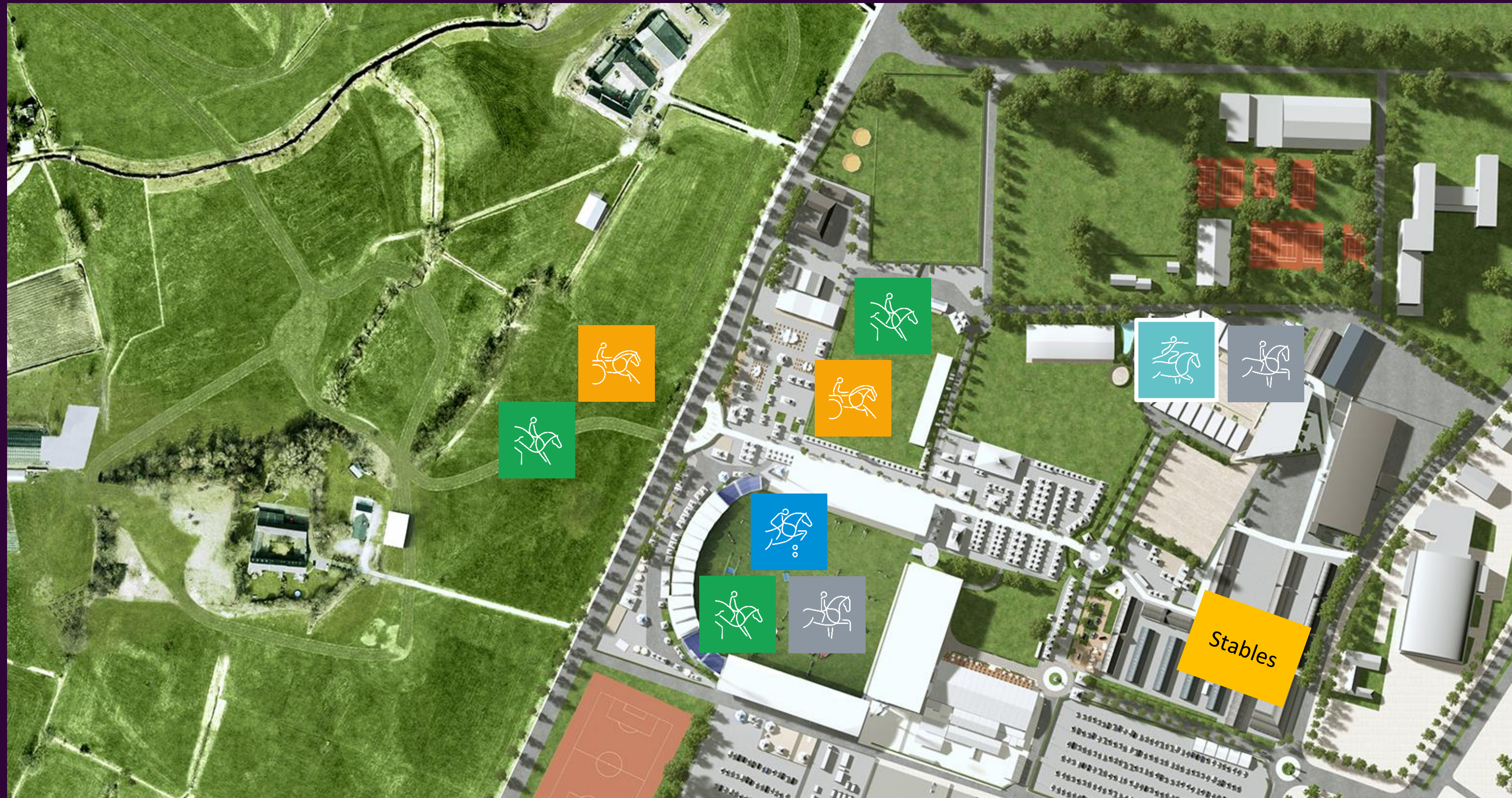

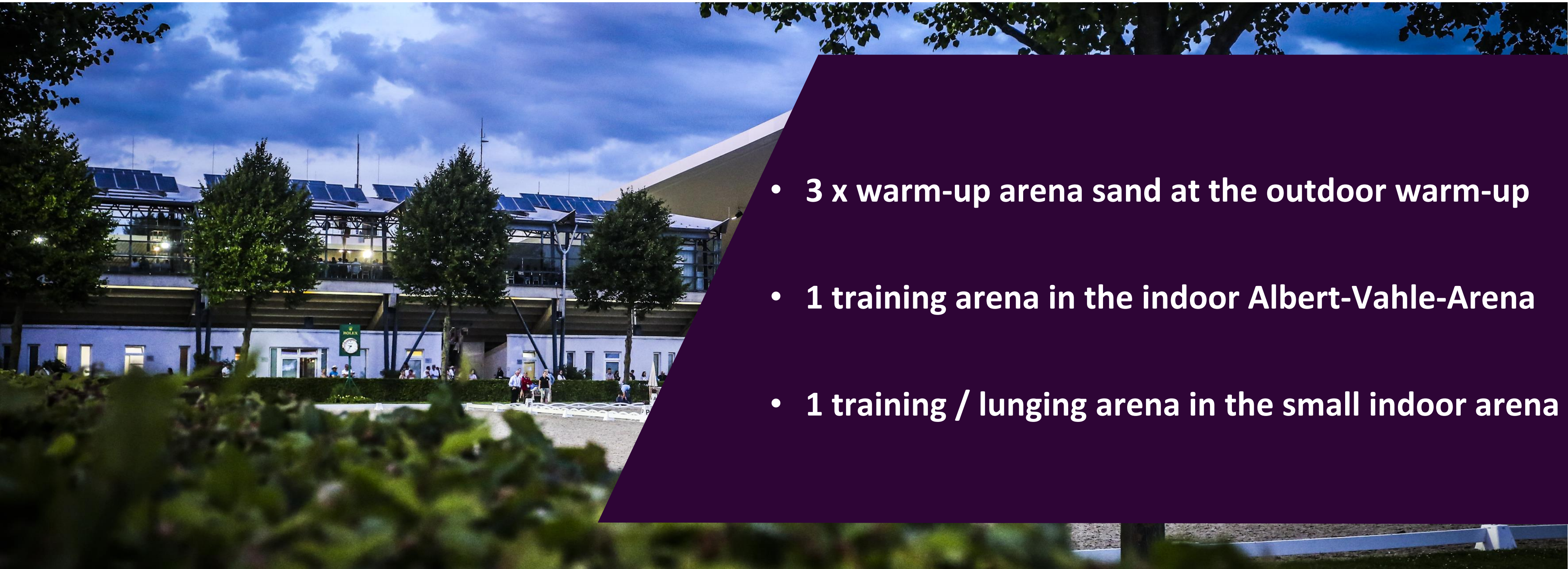


- 50 x 80 sand arena

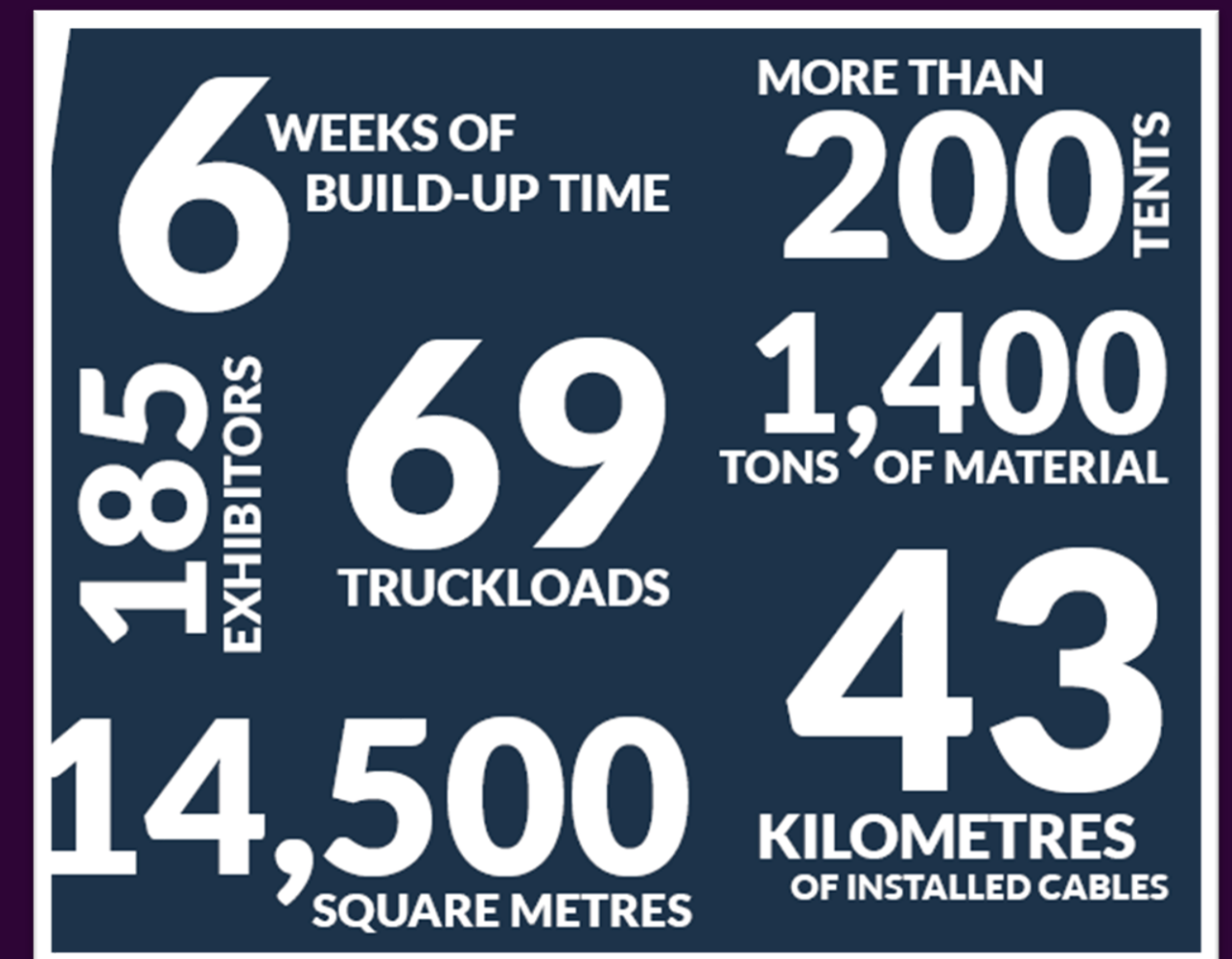

- From fashion items to equestrian sport articles, jewellery, accessories & decorations, through to a new car



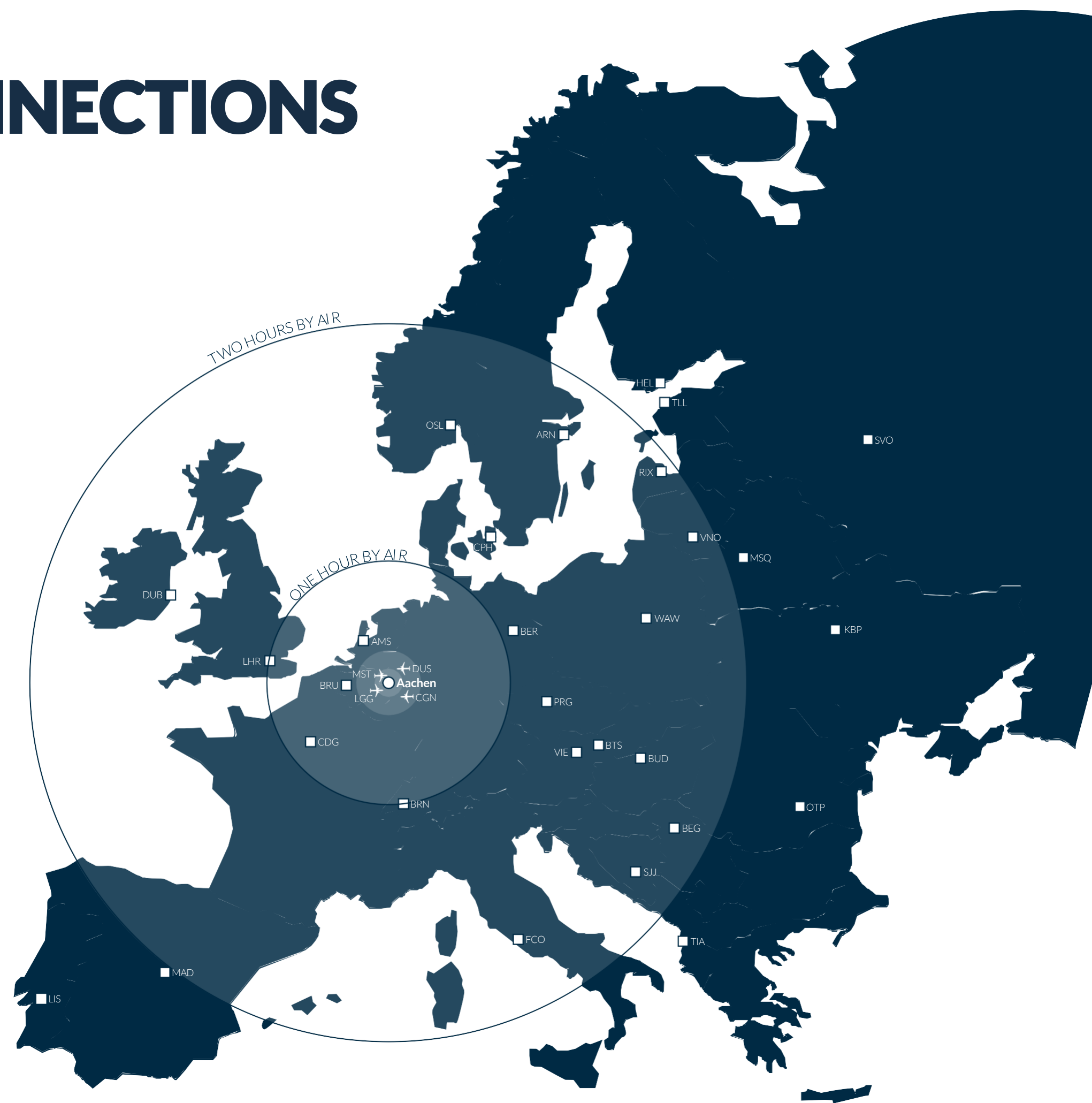
