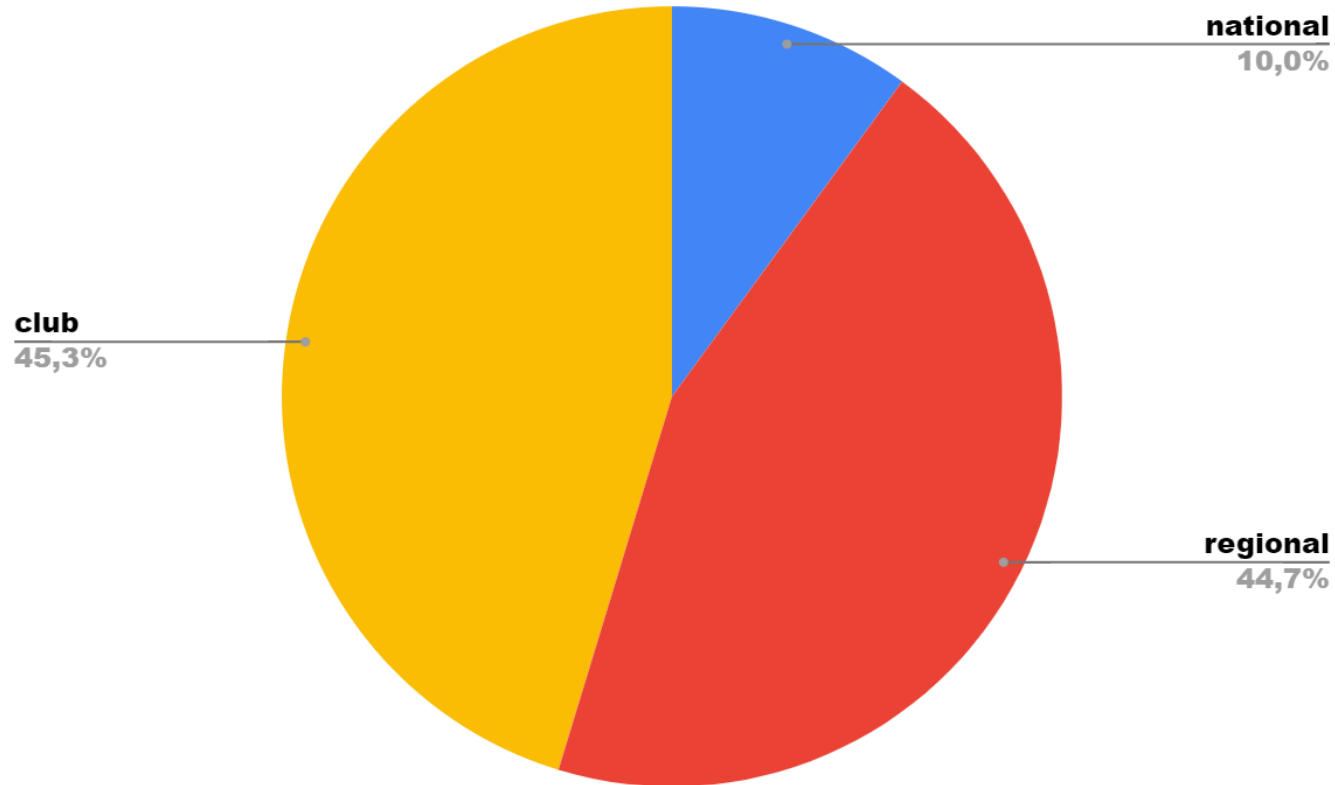
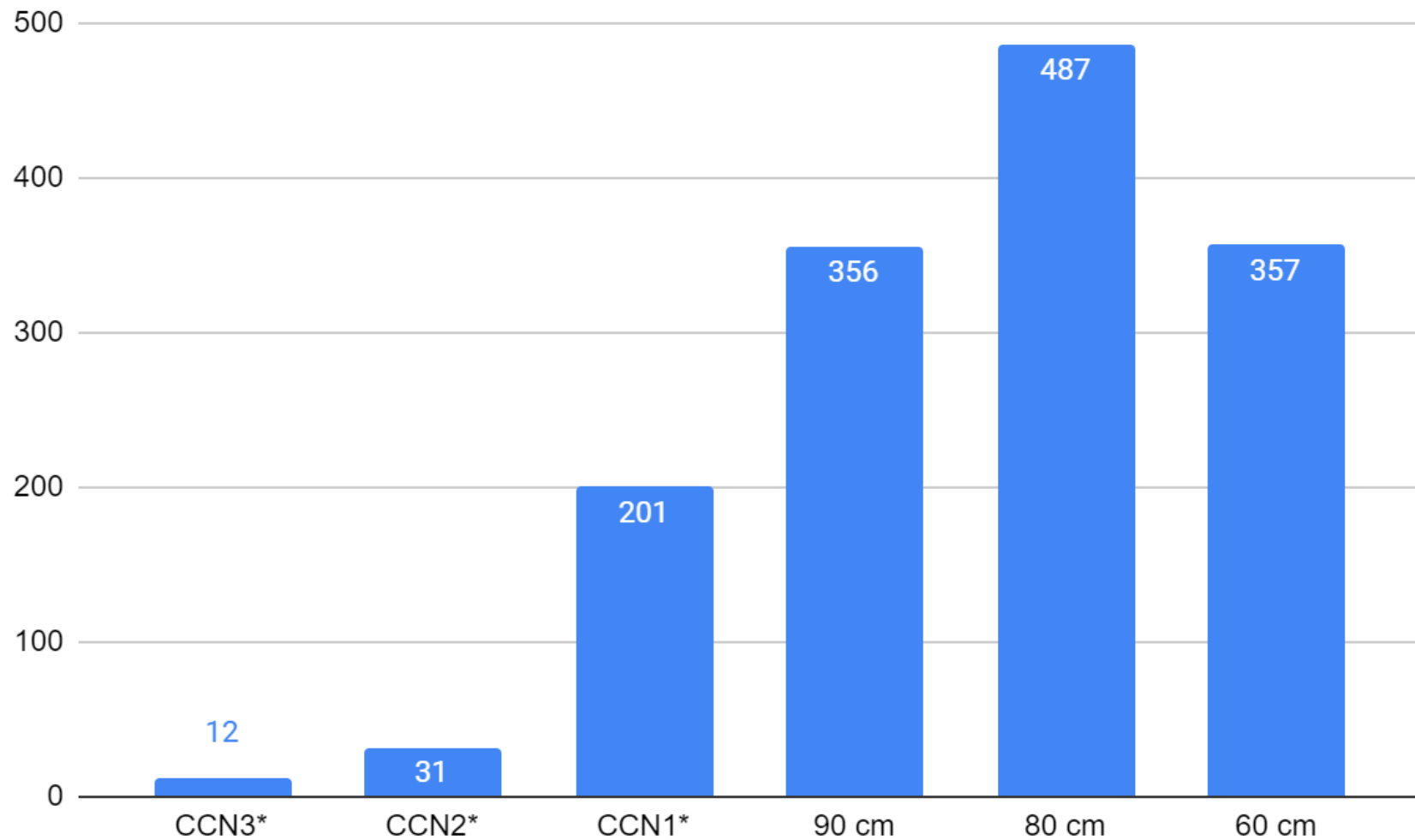


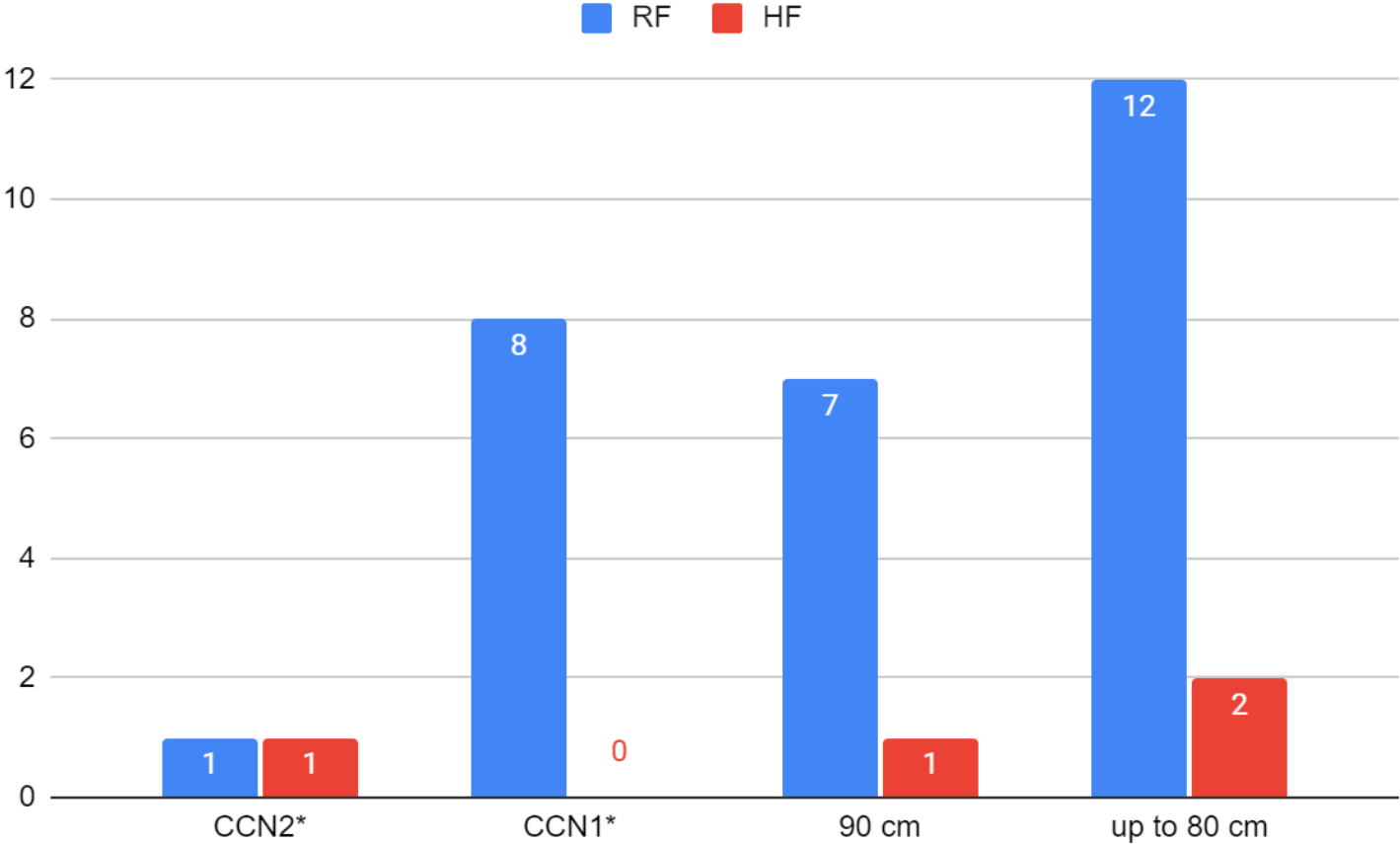


# Background information - 1444 starts 2022





# Total number falls 42 out of 1444 starts



- The number of starts in lower level has increased
- Lack of international competitions and national 2\* and above (2022 one CCI)
- 2023 NBCH in Finland - also new series was created to attract the organizers to organize international competitions - FIN,SWE,EST
- 2 -3 international competition

# Rules

- Trying to keep rules consistent with Fei.
- When the athlete participates in national competitions in other countries she/he must have MER result/s according to the country's rules.
- When athlete takes part first time in CCI competition the athlete must get the national team coach's approval.
- To start CCI1\* level athlete must have 2 MER result from 100 cm
- To start CCI2\* level athlete must have 2 MER result CCI2\* or one CCI2\* and one CCI1\*.

# Safety improvement actions

- Athlete's representative for lower level to help beginners (XC walk, warming up/cooling down)
- Special prize for XC. 1-3 riders will be awarded for the most skillful riding in XC
- Alternative for young horses and beginners is to organize Competition in 60 -100 cm level as XC test. Collegial assessment. Style competition. 1 -3 experienced riders/officials will judge

## Education and federation support

- 1 - 2 times per year seminar in Finland. Experienced TD,CD or trainer from abroad
- Addition annual seminar/courses for promotion/maintenance for all national officials
- Federation support for Fei officials on taking part in Fei education/seminar/courses (Course fee, flights and accommodation)
- Federation support for organizer to acquire frangible technology
