SWE NF Eventing Rules requires at levels starting with P1* and H2* to:

From the 2020 season, all Covered Spread Obstacles without brush at the top, shall be provided with, by the FEI approved Frangible Devices, the exception; Roll Tops/ Curved shaped fences, Houses and Stone Walls as part of a natural stone wall, total width at least 10 m.

Since the 2017 season :


For obstacles without rice of the type triple brush, open oxen, open corner, uprights obstacle type post & rail, gate, requirements for approved Frangible Devices. At an open corner, the requirement is that both front and back rail are equipped with a trigger mechanisms. No part, by an obstacle, may risk injuring horses or riders.








Gemensam profil

Covered Spread

As an example we asked ourselves: **Fences**

Aware of this, can we allow a maximum length of 70 cm at H2* level if we do not have the MiM Table Kit at the obstacle?

Definition of the rule

"Without a MiM Table Kit, the length of the obstacle at the top must not exceed 50% of the allowed Maximum Top Spread for the class."

When does it end to be a Roll Top


Level	Maximum Top Spread	15 % of the length
H2*	140	21 cm
H3*	160	24 cm
H4*	180	27 cm
P1*	120	18 cm 20 cm



Roll Top

Definition of a Roll Top

"Maximum length of the top of a Roll Top is the same as Maximum Top Spread at the level and the height of the upper part shall be at least 15% of the Maximum length at the top, but never less than 20 cm."



Run out – knock down a flag

- ➔ Run out: A Horse is considered to have run out (20 penalties) if, having been presented at an element or obstacle on the course, it avoids.
- ➔ Continuing on course without representing will incur elimination.

Run out – knock down a flag

- ➔ Knock down a flag: A Horse is considered to have knocked down a flag (7 penalties) if the Horse jumps some part of the obstacle and knocks down the flag. This means that some part of the Horse or the Athlete is outside the flags.

Flagpole

- ➔ The pole of the flag shall be rigid. It should ideally be manufactured from wood my be acceptable in some circumstances. The pole should have a height between 180 cm and 210 cm over the ground and a diameter/dimension between 32 mm and 45 mm.

Attachment of the flag

- The Fence Builders are offered 7 methods how the flagpole shall be linked to the obstacle by two attachments. As an example:
- The attachment is created with 2 staples and a 4.8 mm zip-tie.

→ H80 300 cm

→ H90 300 cm

→ H1* 200 cm

→ H2* 170 cm
