Eligibility Criteria

Timeline for Athletes and Horses to achieve the FEI minimum eligibility criteria is from 1 January 2021 through to 3 July 2022, Certificates of Capability to be submitted to the FEI by 4 July 2022.

For the FEI Jumping World Championship for Seniors, Athletes and Horses can achieve the MER according to the following (JRs Annex VIII, Art. 3):

Grand Prix Competitions

- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of three Grand Prix Competitions at selected CSI3* or selected CSIO3* outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of two Grand Prix Competitions at CSI4* outdoor Events or at selected CSIO4* outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of a Grand Prix Competition at a CSI5* or CSIO5* outdoor Event with a Score of not more than four (4) penalties have achieved the MER.

FEI Jumping World Cup™ Competitions

- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of three FEI World Cup™ Competitions at selected CSI1*-W / CSIO1*-W, CSI2*-W / CSIO2*-W and CSI3*-W / CSIO3*-W outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of two FEI World Cup™ Competitions at selected CSI4*-W / CSIO4*-W outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of an FEI World Cup™ Competition at a selected CSI5*-W / CSIO5*-W outdoor Event with a Score of not more than four (4) penalties have achieved the MER.

Nations Cup Competitions

- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first or second round of a Nations Cup Competition at three selected CSIO3* outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first or second round of a Nations Cup Competition at two selected CSIO4* outdoor Events with a Score of zero (0) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first or second round of a Nations Cup Competition at a CSIO5* outdoor Event with a Score of not more than four (4) penalties have achieved the MER.

Championships / Games

- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first or second round of the Team Jumping Competition at the last Jumping European or World Championship or Pan American Games or other FEI Jumping Continental Championship for Seniors (provided the Continental Championship has the status of a qualifying Event for achieving the MER for the Olympic Games and/or World Championship) with a Score of not more than eight (8) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the Individual Jumping Final at the last Jumping European or World Championship or Pan American Games or other FEI Jumping Continental Championship for Seniors (provided the Continental Championship has the status of a qualifying Event for achieving the MER for the Olympic Games and/or World Championship) have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the Individual Jumping Final at the last Olympic Games with a Score of not more than eight (8) penalties have achieved the MER.
- Athletes and Horses that have completed the first Team Jumping Competition (Team Qualifier) or the second Team Jumping Competition (Team Final) at the last Olympic Games with a Score of not more than eight (8) penalties have achieved the MER.

Athletes and Horses are not required to qualify as combinations.
