Dear FEI Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games Delegation,

As some of you are now within the testing period before travel to Tokyo, we would like to remind you of some important points. Please do not forget to refer to the <u>CLO Hub</u> for all updated information.

- Please be aware of your international travel departure time and date, and organise
 your relevant tests within the time required see section <u>Before Travelling to Japan</u>, under the table "Within 7 Days to 96 Hours of your Departure" for testing
 requirements;
- Everything you need to know about how to carry out your pre-travel tests is published in <u>FEI Communication II of 21 July</u>. Please also refer to our <u>FAQ</u>.
- Please <u>URGENTLY</u> let us know if you have not yet received your Meenta tests. By our systems, everyone has either received their tests or is in contact with Fedex to receive delivery, if this is not the case please let us know as soon as possible;
- Once you have taken your Meenta tests, please let us know if there are any issues receiving your results certificate;
- You have been provided with one additional Meenta test in case any in your delivery
 were defective. If you still have a test left over after completing the required pretravel tests, please take it with you to Japan, as it may be useful to have for your
 departure from Japan.
- Meenta is a testing provider approved by Tokyo 2002. In the section Before
 Travelling to Japan on the CLO website hub you can find the List of Approved
 Testing Providers, where Meenta is listed in line 429. Please show this to your
 Airline if there are any questions about whether Meenta is an approved testing
 provider. You can also print the screenshot attached to this email and take it with
 you.;
