

CRITERIA FOR THE ALLOCATION OF THE FEI DRESSAGE WILD CARD

- All requests for the FEI Dressage Wild Card must come from the Athlete's NF and only.
- NF can apply, on behalf of an Athlete, for an FEI Dressage Wild Card maximum three (3) times per calendar year or per FEI Dressage World Cup season.
- FEI Dressage Wild Card requests for CDI5* or CDI-W events will be considered on a case-by-case basis, taking into account all previous results of the concerned Athlete/Horse combination.
- FEI Dressage Wild Card for a CDI5* event: an Athlete/Horse combination must have achieved at least one (1) Grand Prix or Grand Prix Special result of min 65% at a CDI3* or CDI4* event (as total average score).
- FEI Dressage Wild Card for a CDI4* event: an Athlete/Horse combination must have achieved at least one (1) Grand Prix or Grand Prix Special result of min 63% at a CDI3* event (as total average score).
- FEI Dressage Wild Cards for a CDI3* event will be available to Athletes from developing NFs and to Athletes from NFs not having received invitations but requiring Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MERs) scores for an FEI Dressage Championship.
- If several requests are received for the same event, first time request will take priority over those requesting the FEI Dressage wild card for a second or third time.
- Priority will be given to Athlete/Horse combinations trying to qualify for an FEI Dressage Game and/or Championship.
