### Requirements

- ✓ **Be proposed by the JSP as a prospective Level 4 Judge**
- ✓ English proficiency grade of B2 or higher
- ✓ FEI Level 3 Judge for a minimum of 3 years
- ✓ Be in good standing with the FEI
- Officiating experience within 10 years of application**
- ✓ 30 competitions at Grand Prix Level, CDIs 4\* or above
- ✓ 6 CDIs 3\* as President of the Ground Jury or Foreign Judge
- ✓ 2 Championships at different levels (World Cup Finals, Young Horse World Breeding Championships, U25 Continental CH, Youth Continental CHs)

### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
  - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
  - ✓ 15 International Grand Prix level competitions within the last 3 years as a Level 4 Judge <sup>1</sup>
  - ✓ 8 CDIs 3\* or above within the last 3 years as a Level 4 Judge <sup>1</sup>

- ✓ Pass 2 positive Shadow Judging examinations at GP with 2 different MJs - min. 8 horses per Shadow Judging done in first class on respective level at the show
- ✓ Pass a Level 3 Judges Transfer-up course (3 days)

- ✓ Be listed as a GP Level national Dressage Judge with 9 national Competitions on GP Level within the last 3 years

#### For Level 1 Judges

- ✓ English proficiency grade of A2 or higher
- ✓ 1 Year & 6 CDIs 1\*/2\* as a Level 1 Judge with 12 competitions on PSG/Inter I level

### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
  - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
  - ✓ 6 Inter A/B or higher within the last 3 years\* as a Level 2 Judge <sup>1</sup>
  - ✓ 6 intl. events\*\* within the last 3 years as a Level 2 Judge <sup>1</sup>

- ✓ Pass 3 positive Shadow Judging examinations at GP with 2 different MJs - min. 8 horses per Shadow Judging done in first class on respective Level at the event

- ✓ 9 National Competitions at PSG/Inter I within the last 3 years as a listed National PSG Judge

### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
  - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
  - ✓ 6 PSG/Inter I within the last 3 years\* as a Level 1 Judge <sup>1</sup>
  - ✓ 3 intl. events\*\* or FEI Challenges (PSG) within the last 3 years as a Level 1 Judge <sup>1</sup>

- ✓ Pass 2 Shadow Judging examinations at PSG/Inter I with 2 different FEI Approved MJs - min. 8 horses per Shadow Judging done in first class on respective Level at CDI
- ✓ Pass a Young Horse course (2-3 days)
- ✓ Pass the Level 1 Judges Transfer-up course (2-3 days)
