

- 1 year & 3 Intl. Shows (CVIs) as a Level 1 Judge

- 1 Intl. Show (CVI) or Vaulting Challenge within the last 3 years as a Level 1 Judge*

*condition non applicable for the initial 3 years of officiating at Level 1

- Completed online Vaulting Foundation Course
- 2 passed Sit-Ins at Intl. Shows (CVIs) in the last 3 years

- *Pass 2 Shadow Judgings Level 1 at Intl. Shows (CVIs), 1 may be online Compulsory, Free and Technical Tests - Horse Score Compulsory Test (1, 2, 3) - Exercise Score Free Test - Technique Score (Performance, Degree of Difficulty)
