

## **2023 FEI EVENTING EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS Le Pin au Haras (FRA), 09-13 August 2023, CH-EU-CCI4\*-L Qualification Requirements**

### **QUALIFICATION PERIOD (FEI Eventing rules Art 518.1):**

**Start: 1 January 2022**

**End: 10 July 2023**

The period for obtaining a MER for Championships is from the preceding calendar year to the closing of the championship nominated entries.

### **MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS (FEI Eventing Rules, Art. 521)**

For the Eventing European Championships, Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MERs)\* must be achieved as a combination as follows:

*NF requirements + 1 MER CCI4\*-L*

All MERs must be achieved as a combination and must be clear on the obstacles of the Cross Country Test. The 1st activation of a frangible /deformable device (11 penalties) or having one missed flag (15 penalties) will still allow a MER.

### **\* Minimum Eligibility Requirements (FEI Eventing Rules, Art. 517)**

A Minimum Eligibility Requirement is achieved by completing a Competition within minimum parameters of all round performance as follows:

a) Dressage Test: not more than 45 penalty points (or 55%).

b) Cross Country test:

- Cross Country Test: A clear round at obstacles (activating a maximum of one frangible device or having a maximum of one missing flag will maintain the MER result on Cross Country)
- Not more than 75 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross Country Test for, two, three and four star level Competitions and 100 seconds in the case of five star level Competitions.

c) Jumping test: not more than 16 penalties at obstacles.
