
FEI Solidarity Department operations






FEI Coach Education Programme celebrating 20 years

Timeline:

- 2003 Working group in charge of outlining a development strategy which included the creation of a practical coach education system.
- **2004** First Level 1 courses in Olympic disciplines were delivered
- **2005** First Level 2 courses in Olympic disciplines were delivered
- **2013** First Level 1 courses in Vaulting were delivered
- **2014** First Level 3 courses in Olympic disciplines were delivered
- **2017** First Level 1 courses in Endurance were delivered
- 2019 Creation of a Level 2 module in Vaulting
- 2020 Creation of a Level 1 module in Para Dressage
