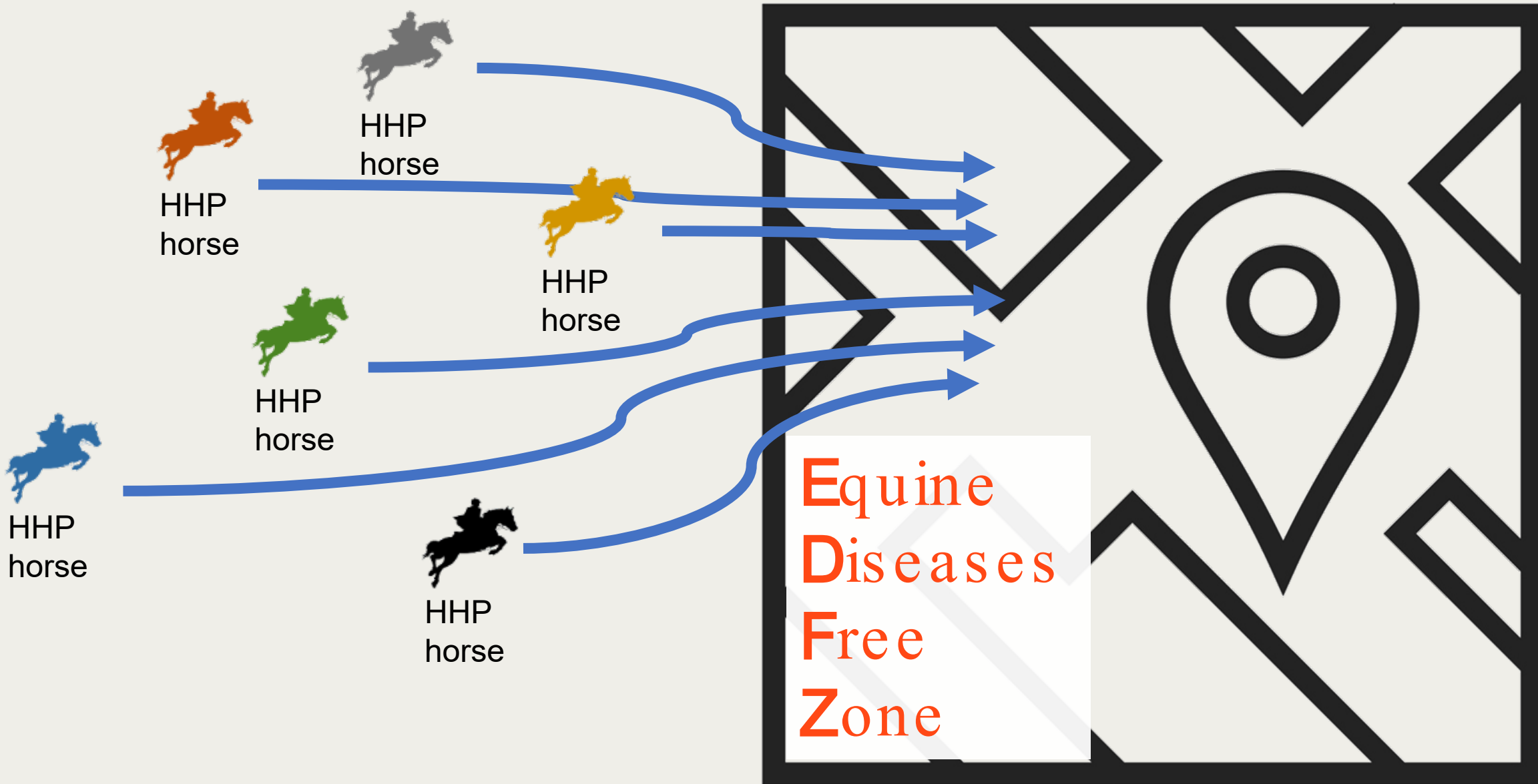

- Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis

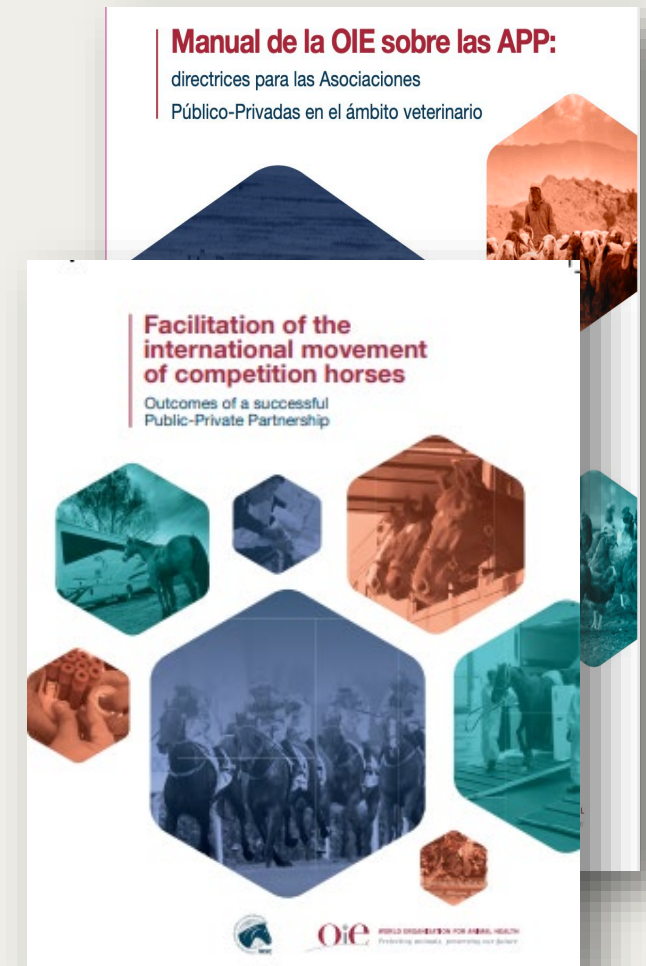
Terrestrial Code Standards

Outdated and non-standardized approach

- Collaboration and update of Code Chapters
- Revision and future update of Model Passport
