- ✓ English proficiency grade of C1 or higher
- ✓ FEI Level 3 Steward for a minimum of 2 years
- ✓ Be in good standing with the FEI
- Officiating experience within 10 years of application**
- ✓ 3 CPEDIs 3\* as a Chief Steward
- ✓ 2 Championships as a Stewarding Team Member

#### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 3 intl. events within the last 3 years as a Level 4 Steward

#### Education

- For Transfer-up**
- ✓ Pass the Level 4 Stewards blended learning programme with examination(s)
    - Online Level 4 Stewards examination
    - Online interview
    - In-person course of 3 days

#### Status

- Level 4 Para Dressage Steward**
- ✓ On passing the Level 4 final blended learning programme with examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 4 Stewards in the FEI Database

#### Requirements

- ✓ English proficiency grade of B2 or higher
- ✓ FEI Level 2 Steward for a minimum of 2 years
- ✓ 3 intl. events as a Level 2 Steward within the last 3 years

#### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 1 intl. event in the last 3 years as a Level 3 Steward

#### Education

- For Transfer-up**
- ✓ Pass a Level 3 Stewards in-person transfer-up course with examination

#### Status

- Level 3 Para Dressage Steward**
- ✓ On passing the Level 3 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 3 Stewards in the FEI Database

- For Level 1 Stewards**
- ✓ English proficiency grade of B1 or higher
  - ✓ 1 year & 1 intl. event as a Level 1 Steward

#### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
  - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
  - ✓ 1 intl. event within the last 3 years\* as a Level 2 Steward
- \*condition non applicable to Equivalency Officials for the initial 3 years of officiating

- ✓ Pass a Level 2 Stewards in-person transfer-up course with examination

- \*condition non applicable for the initial 3 years of officiating at level 1
