FEI President begins term in office at ASOIF

On 1 January, the FEI President began his term in office at the head of the Association of Summer Olympic International Federations (ASOIF).

In the same month, the new ASOIF President met with the President of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and the Presidents of the International Federations on the programme of Los Angeles 2028 for a two-day transition seminar, which took place at Olympic House, the IOC Headquarters and the Olympic Museum in Lausanne (SUI).

In addition, the IOC President expressed his warm thanks to the International Federations for their continued support before and during the Paris 2024 Olympic Games and presented each of them with a Paris 2024 torch in recognition of their contribution to the outstanding success of the Games.

Following the IOC seminar, Ingmar De Vos chaired the ASOIF Council for the first time. The new ASOIF President underscored his commitment to an open dialogue with the member

federations, as he presented his plans to conduct a membership survey to capture members' insights, which will directly inform ASOIF's Strategic Plan for the future. He also reiterated the importance of maintaining close and constructive relations with the IOC.

The ASOIF Council discussed the LA28 Transition Seminar to address key topics related to Games planning. Commenting on the outcomes of the meeting, Ingmar De Vos said, "We encourage LA28 to take advantage of the International Federations' deep knowledge in organising major competitions for their respective sports. Through our Olympic and Multi-Sports Games Consultative Group, we are ready to help drive progress, tackle issues and provide innovative yet pragmatic solutions."

Ingmar De Vos was elected unanimously as the new ASOIF President on 9 April 2024, at the 48th ASOIF General Assembly held in Birmingham (GBR) during the SportAccord World Sport and Business Summit. He ran unopposed and was elected by secret ballot for a term of four years. He took up his new position on 1 January 2025.

Internal Regulations of the FEI Tribunal

The fourth edition of the Internal Regulations of the FEI Tribunal, effective as of 1 February 2025 and approved by the FEI Tribunal, is available on the **General Regs & Statutes** page. A mark-up version showing the changes is also available on this page.

These Internal Regulations of the FEI Tribunal replace those last updated on 2 March 2018. Cases already pending before any Hearing Panels as of 1 February 2025 shall continue

to be governed by the previous version of the FEI Tribunal Internal Regulations. However, Part III (Procedural Rules of the FEI Tribunal) shall apply, where practicable, to all cases brought before the FEI Tribunal for Decision after 1 February 2025.

FEI Eventing Forum and NSO Seminar 2025

The summary of discussions, annexes and photos of the Eventing Forum and National Safety Officers (NSOs) Seminar, held in Lausanne (SUI) from 17 to 19 January 2025 have been published on the **FEI Eventing Risk Management page**. All sessions are also available to watch on "replay".

Eventing Risk Management Programme - Eventing Statistics Report 2013-2024

The Eventing Statistics Report (2013–2024) and Horse Falls per fence types (2016-2024) have been finalised. They are published on the FEI website under Eventing/Risk Management.

FEI Eventing Officials Education System

The second edition of the **FEI Eventing Officials Education System** document is now available online.

This document details the pathways for officials, explaining the education levels and requirements for courses, seminars, and the promotion of International Eventing Officials within the FEI.

A key enhancement is the introduction of the FEI Course Designer Mentoring Programme, which provides an alternative, accelerated pathway for candidates with outstanding talent in course design.

The review of the education system was conducted by the Eventing Education Working Group, incorporating extensive consultation and collaboration with key stakeholders in the Eventing community.

Due to extensive formatting revisions, a mark-up version is not available; however, the key changes that have been approved by the FEI Eventing Committee. A summary of the main changes is available **here**.

The updated FEI Eventing Dressage Tests for 2025 are now available online. While no major changes have been made, some test elements have been combined or split to ensure more consistent scoring. In line with Article 543.1.2 of the FEI Eventing Rules, the Dressage tests for all Championships and Games in 2025 have been approved by the FEI Eventing Committee, taking into account the preferences of the relevant Organising Committees.
