## Job title

FEI Level 2-4 Endurance Veterinary Treating Official

## Job analysis

### All levels

The FEI Endurance Veterinary Treating Official ensures that horse welfare is paramount at FEI events.

**A Level 2-4 Endurance Veterinary Treating Official** advises on the health status of horses, provide clinical care and treatment in accordance with the Veterinary Regulations at an international event and ensure the continuous cooperation between all Officials and other principal stakeholders is respected and upheld in order to achieve the best possible outcome of the event.

## Profile

### All Levels

- To have an English proficiency grade of B1-C2 respectively
- To be current with the FEI maintenance status for Officials
- To have knowledge relative to the Level in the following areas:
  - FEI Endurance Rules and Veterinary Regulations
  - Horsemanship and Horse management
- To be able to assess situations and take prompt and appropriate decisions
- To be able to take responsibility
- To be team oriented
- To be physically able to carry out the FEI Endurance Veterinary Treating Official's tasks

### As Level 4

Supplemental to the above-mentioned characteristics:

- To have an English proficiency grade of C1-C2 respectively
- To have good interpersonal skills
- To have good communication skills
- To be able to handle high pressure situations
- To have (respectively) good/excellent knowledge in the following areas:
  - Event organisation
  - Team management
  - Conflict management
  - Time management

- Legal matters

## Reports to

**The Endurance Veterinary Treating Official** reports to the President of the Veterinary Treating Commission.

## Team management

**A Level 3 and 4 Endurance Veterinary Treating Official** as a President of an Endurance Veterinary Treating Commission is responsible for organising the Endurance Veterinary Treating Commission.

## Key responsibilities

### All Levels

- Respect the FEI Officials Code of Conduct

### As a Member of the Endurance Veterinary Treating Commission

#### During each Event

- Provide treatment to horses

### As a President of the Endurance Veterinary Treating Commission

#### Before the start of each Event

- Liaise with the OC and VSM to ensure the equine treatment facilities meet all requirements as described by the Veterinary Regulations
- Be aware of all contingency plans, biosecurity measures and organisation of the Examination on Arrival

#### During each Event

- Liaise with the President of Endurance Veterinarian Commission, Foreign Veterinary Delegate, President of the Ground Jury, the Chief Steward and the OC and all other stakeholders
- Ensure all emergency protocols and preparations are in place
