FEI Vaulting Stewards' levels

IMPORTANT NOTE

*FEI Vaulting Stewards newly transferred up to Level 2 (on 01.01.2021) cannot be appointed as Chief Steward in 2021, as they had been transferred up in view of the new Vaulting Education System that has 4 Levels; however, given the existing Vaulting Rules, the possibility to officiate as Chief Steward must be limited only to Level 3 and 4 Stewards.

To become an FEI Level 4 Vaulting Steward, you will need to pass the FEI Level 4 blended learning course (refer to the FEI Vaulting Officials' Education System)

FEI Vaulting Judges' levels

There is no change to the existing levels of FEI Vaulting Judges in relation to the FEI Vaulting Officials' Education System, effective 1 January 2021. Other than that, in order to become an FEI Level 4 Vaulting Judge, you will need to pass the FEI Level 4 blended learning course (refer to the FEI Vaulting Officials Education System).
