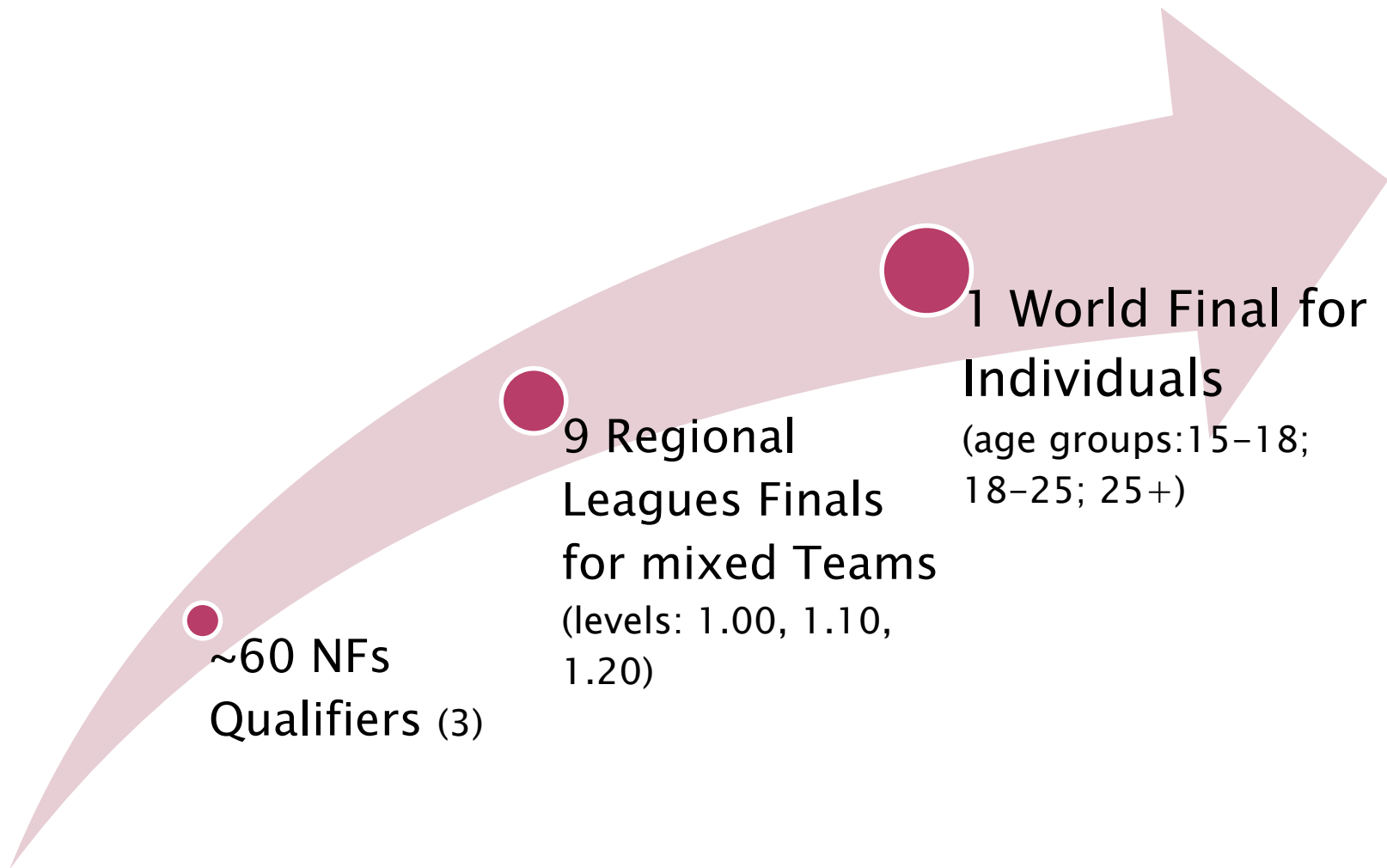


# FEI WORLD JUMPING CHALLENGE LEAGUE FORMAT

## **The Concept:**

- ⦿ Challenge-type leagues format
- ⦿ 3 age groups (15-18; 18-25; 25+)
- ⦿ 3 technical levels (1.00, 1.10, 1.20)
- ⦿ Regional League Finals
- ⦿ World Final
- ⦿ All Finals with borrowed horses

# NATIONAL QUALIFIERS

- ◎ NFs shall organise **3 Qualifiers** to count for rankings
  - Course plans shall be provided by the FEI
  - 3 technical levels (1.00 m; 1.10 m; 1.20 m)
  - Open to Athletes from 15 yrs old and over
  - National Qualifiers qualify for Regional League Finals
  
- ◎ NFs shall organise **National Rankings**
  - A national ranking of 1.20 m Athletes
  - A national ranking of 1.10 m Athletes
  - A national ranking of 1.00 m Athletes

# REGIONAL LEAGUE FINALS

- ⦿ The Regional Leagues Finals are based on National Rankings
- ⦿ Each NF of the Leagues qualifies a **mixed Team** of 3 Athletes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete @ 1.20 m from national ranking
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete @ 1.10 m from national ranking
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete @ 1.00 m from national ranking
- ⦿ Age of Athletes: 15 +
- ⦿ Team podium
- ⦿ Regional Finals with borrowed horses

# WORLD FINAL

- ⦿ The World Final is based on Regional Leagues rankings of 1.20 m Athletes
- ⦿ Each Regional League qualifies **3 Individual** Athletes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete aged 15-18 from regional ranking
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete aged 18-25 from regional ranking
  - 1<sup>st</sup> placed Athlete aged 25 + from regional ranking
- ⦿ Individual Podium for each age group
- ⦿ World Final with borrowed horses

# SIMULATION – REGIONAL FINALS

- 9 Regional League Finals
- 8 NFs per League (average)
- 3 Athletes per NF: 1 per technical level  
1.20, 1.10, 1.00
- Age of Athletes 15+
- Total: 24 Finalists per League



# SIMULATION – WORLD FINAL

- ⦿ 9 Regional Leagues
- ⦿ 3 Athletes per League: 1 per age group  
15-18; 18-25; 25+
- ⦿ Technical level: 1.20 m
- ⦿ Total: 27 Finalists
