President of the Ground Jury acting as Technical Delegate

According to the FEI Driving World Cup™ Rules, article 10.5, the PGJ can also act as TD.

Extract of the FEI Driving WC™ Rules:

10.5 A Technical Delegate, if appointed, must check all technical aspects of the Competition, or the PGJ will also act as TD.

Duties of President of the Ground Jury acting as Technical Delegate

- Check the Stables with FEI Steward
- Approve the Horse Inspection Lane and the appropriate Times
- Check the Warm Up Areas with FEI Steward
- Approve the Arena with the CD
- Check the Jury box facilities (requirements and numbers)
- Check the communication between Jury box and Arena
- Check that Warm Up Times are correct with FEI Steward
- Check that the Briefings and Draw are correctly organized with the OC
- Organise Athletes Meeting with the OC
- Check that the Course Designer has everything ready for smooth construction and sufficient time
- Check that drawings of Course are correct and given to the Athletes with the CD
- Check that Athletes have ample "Walk Time"
- Check that the Timing and displays for public are correctly displayed
- Check that decorations are ready for course
- Check that there is sufficient time to build the Course and sufficient time for the Athletes to walk
- Check when and where the Course is harrowed and timings required
- Liaise with Timekeepers and for the Music for Competition (Volume and intensity)
- Discuss with Speaker
- Hold a briefing with Arena Staff: When to replace balls and when to re-build
- Check that the Jury box has all necessary requirements
- Check the Field Judge(s) have good communication with the Jury box
- Check that all paperwork for Jury and back up timing are set
- Organise the Prize Giving's
 - check How many PM Ceremonies
 - Showboating or not and how long
 - Sponsors on Carriages or not
