

Education

For Transfer-up

Status

Level 3 Para Dressage Judge

- Pass a Level 3 Judges in-person transfer-up course \checkmark with examination
- Pass 1 positive Shadow Judging at CPEDI3* all Grades with minimum 1 competition per Grade in Para Grand Prix A and/or Para Grand Prix B, with minimum 3 Athletes in each Grade, within the last three years
- ✓ On passing the Level 3 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 3 Judges in the FEI Database



Ground Jury Member

Requirements

- For National Para Dressage Judges from NFs with Equivalency
- English proficiency grade of B1 or higher
- ✓ Formally recommended by National Federation
- Completed online Para Dressage Foundation Course
- Passed online Level 1 Judges Equivalency Examination

For National Dressage Judges (PSG level) & FEI Dressage Judges (all levels)

- English proficiency grade of B1 or higher \checkmark
- Formally recommended by National Federation \checkmark
- Completed online Para Dressage Foundation Course
- ✓ Passed online Level 1 Judges Equivalency Examination

For Level 1 Para Dressage Judges

- English proficiency grade of B1 or higher
- 2 years & 4 intl. events* as a Level 1 Judge 2 international events can be replaced by 2 FEI Challenges

Education

For National Para Dressage Judges from NFs with Equivalency

Complete 1 sit-in covering all five grades with minimum 1 competition per Grade in Para Grand Prix A and/or Para Grand Prix B, and minimum 1 Para Grand Prix Freestyle in all Grades

For National Dressage Judges (PSG level) & FEI Dressage Judges (all levels)

Complete 1 sit-in covering Grades I, II and III with minimum 1 competition per Grade in Para Grand Prix A and/or Para Grand Prix B, and minimum 1 Para Grand Prix Freestyle per Grade (I, II and III)

For Level 1 Para Dressage Judges

Complete 1 sit-in covering all five grades with minimum 1 competition per Grade in Para Grand Prix A and/or Para Grand Prix B, and minimum 1 Para Grand Prix Freestyle in all Grades

Additionally for all applicants

- Pass a Level 2 Judges in-person transfer-up course \checkmark with examination
- Pass 1 positive shadow judging at CPEDI3* all Grades with minimum 1 competition per Grade in Para Grand Prix A and/or Para Grand Prix B, with minimum 3 Athletes per Grade, within the last 3 years

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year 📃
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 3 intl. events** within the last 3 years* as a Level 2 Judge ¹
 - * condition non applicable to Equivalency Officials and National
 - Dressage Judges for the initial 3 years of officiating ** 1 intl. event can be replaced by a virtual judging seminar

Level 2 Para Dressage Judge

On passing the Level 2 examination(s) and fulfilling all \checkmark requirements, participants are listed as Level 2 Judges in the FEI Database



Requirements

- English proficiency grade of A2 or higher
- ✓ Formally recommended by National Federation
- ✓ Completed online Para Dressage Foundation Course
- Be a listed as National Judge (FEI Junior test)

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year □
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ 6 PSG/Inter I within the last 3 years* as a Level 1 Judge ¹
- ✓ 3 intl. events** or FEI Chalenges within the last 3 years* as a Level 1 Judge ¹

* condition non applicable for the initial 3 years of officiating at Level 1 ** 1 intl. event can be replaced by a virtual judging seminar

Education

For National Para Dressage Judges

- ✓ Complete 1 sit-in covering all five grades with 2 positive recommendations by FEI approved Mentor Judges to be completed before application deadline of transfer-up course
- ✓ Pass a Level 1 Judges transfer-up course with examination to be completed before shadow judging evaluations
- Pass 2 shadow judgings with positive evaluations from 2 different FEI approved Mentor Judges in all Grades with a min. of 3 Horses - maximum 5 attempts

✓ On passing the Level 1 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 1 Judges in the FEI Database
