- Experience as a National Para Equestrian Classifier

Education

For National Para Equestrian Classifiers

Be mentored by 1 or more Level 2 or above Para Equestrian Classifiers (Mentor Classifiers) for the entire duration of their Level 1 Status

National Para Equestrian Classifiers

All roles according to the FEI Para Dressage Rules Art. 8440
