- Current scoring system concept example
- Driven Dressage average score, originally given in percentage, then
   transformed into penalty points multiplied with a certain coefficient +
- Marathon total time taken in the obstacles and penalties transformed to penalty points +
- Cones course penalty points (balls down, time exceeding) added to the D+M scores.

- New Driven Dressage scoring concept: example
- Result in %: 80% for the number 1
- Result in %: 75% for the number 2
- Difference between number 1 and 2 is 5%, multiplied by 4 seconds equals 20 seconds.

Number 1 starts at zero and number 2 starts with 20 seconds in the Marathon.

- New Marathon scoring concept: example
- Number 1 has 50 seconds due to various penalties (ball down, groom down, etc.) +
- 400 seconds in the Marathon competition (total time taken in the 8 Marathon obstacles) =
- 450 seconds total in the Marathon competition for the number 1 and the number 2 was
   faster in the obstacles and had a total of 435 seconds in the marathon +
- O seconds to add. For the number 1 zero (O) to add for the dressage and 20 seconds for the number 2 to add for the dressage
- Total number 1 is 450 seconds ( 450 marathon and 0 dressage)
- Total number 2 is 435 seconds in marathon and 20 in dressage= 455 seconds

Number 1 starts with 0 seconds and Number 2 starts with 5 seconds on the clock.



#### Pair Horses



- New Cones scoring concept : example
- Number 2 starts first, he starts with 5 seconds on the clock, on the finish he has a time of 194 seconds (included the 5 from the start) and 1 ball (15 seconds) makes 209 seconds
- Number 1 has now 209 seconds to finish his course.
- When he starts, he got 209 seconds to finish the course on the clock in a countdown. So everybody can see how much time is left on the clock, when he hits a ball, the 15 seconds goes off from this time.

If the second Athlete has less time on the clock after his round, then he is the winner.

## **FEI Driving Scoring System**

- Advantages of the new scoring system
- Easier to understand for the Public/Officials/Athletes/Scoring Office
- Easier to calculate for the Scoring Office
- Easier data handling for Service Providers
- Less possibility to make calculation errors
- Eliminates judging mistakes
- Creates more excitement during the Event
- Immediate results at the end of the Event
- Keeps the balance between the three competitions
- Makes Driving Sport more popular and understandable



#### **Current situation**

- Very few of the Horses sent to Holding Box were actually not fit to compete.
- The inspection during the Halt of the Marathon has very little importance.
- Most of the welfare concerns appear during training before and in between competitions.




## Overview of the current inspections - details

- Massive concentration of Horses
  - The first HI can be dangerous: lots of Horses at the same time, footing usually on asphalt.
- 2. Important time lapse between 1st HI and Check after Dressage
- 3. Absence of Inspection before Dressage
  - Sometimes, 24 hours happen between those two inspections, in which Horses can clearly be over trained and not fit to compete anymore.
- 4. Outdated inspection before the Section B of the Marathon
  - This inspection was important when Marathon had 5 sections. In reality, a very low risk is posed to the Horse during the 1st section of the current 2 or 3 sections Marathons.
- 5. Absence of a Mandatory Cool Down
  - For Welfare concerns, it appears very important to have a mandatory cool down after a consequent effort such as a Marathon.

## Overview of the proposed Inspections - details

- The proposed inspections allow for a constant monitoring of the Horses by the Veterinarians, due to the addition of an inspection before Dressage, and before Marathon.
- The Horses are checked before and after every competition.
- The new inspections are focused on Horse Welfare and safety of the Participants.
- It solves many negative points raised during the last years, such as footing issues during HI and overall Horse welfare concerns.

# Differences between 2 and 3\* Events

#### Differences between 2\* and 3\* Events

- 2\* events are for education of Horses and new International Drivers.
- Qualification for World Championships only during 3\* Events
- Dressage tests specifically designed for 2\* Events
- Less Obstacles in Marathon competitions
- Lower speeds in the Marathon Sections
- Reinstalling flowing Cones course: reduce multiple obstacles
