The ECIU going forward

- Quest No longer acting as the ECIU
- If the FEI then needs to investigate any allegations or incidents,
 the FEI will be free to use any service provider
- The Board has approved the appointment of Martin Gibbs (GBR) as Chair of the Equestrian Community Integrity Unit.
- Martin Gibbs is a former member of the FEI Tribunal, former Director General of the *Union Cycliste Internationale* (UCI), and is the current Managing Director of SportAccord.




New ECIU's Terms of Reference

- The ECIU shall be composed between one (1) and up to three (3) persons (including the Chair), at the discretion of the Board.
- Term of 4 years (which can be renewed)
- The role of the ECIU is to perform the following functions:
 - Review and/or investigate (if applicable) any alleged breaches of FEI Rules
 - May review and/or enquire regarding investigations conducted by the FEI and/or on behalf
 of the FEI to ensure that they are reasonable, proportionate, and in compliance with all
 applicable laws, regulations, and policies of the FEI
 - Provide an independent report to the FEI following an ECIU investigation, if requested by the FEI.
 - Provide a written Report to the FEI General Assembly on the activities of the ECIU.

Everyone involved in our sport, has the innate right to be safe and treated with respect. The FEI will not tolerate any forms of abuse or misconduct as this goes against the best interests of our sport. The same applies to horses and it is our collective responsibility to be the guardians of horse welfare within equestrian sport.

Misconduct can occur in different ways and should always be reported. In order to facilitate the reporting process of any behaviour or incident that breeches the FEI Rules and/or the integrity of equestrian sport, we have created different categories with the appropriate reporting and contact information.
