<b>Aim:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To provide assistant coaches with the ability to prepare riders for competitions. Emphasizing skill, develop participation and enjoyment</li> </ul>
<b>Duration of the course:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4 days (2 + 2)</li> </ul>
<b>Material:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Workbook</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Requirements for Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>18 years old and over</li> <li>Have a knowledge of horses and horsemanship (responsibility of the NF)</li> <li>Have completed an FEI Introduction to Coaching course or be recommended by their NF</li> <li>Have a First Aid Safety certificate (recommendation)</li> </ul>
<b>Attendance:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>14 participants + observers</li> </ul>
<b>Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be registered with their NF</li> </ul>
<b>Level:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Jumping: 1.00 - 1.15 m</li> <li>Dressage: Preliminary/Elementary</li> <li>Eventing: Novice up to 1*</li> </ul>
