<b>Aim:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To provide coaches with the ability to prepare horses and vaulters for competitions at elementary level.</li> <li>• To emphasize basic skills, develop participation and enjoyment</li> <li>• To inform the participants about the course, its contents, and to improve the ability of the participants to work as a vaulting coach.</li> </ul>
<b>Duration of the course:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 days (40 hours)</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Requirements for Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 16 years old and over</li> <li>• Have a knowledge of horses and horsemanship (responsibility of the NF)</li> <li>• Have be recommended by the their NF</li> <li>• Have a First Aid Safety certificate (recommendation)</li> </ul>
<b>Attendance:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>14</b> participants + 10 observers (max)</li> </ul>
<b>Participants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be registered with their NF</li> </ul>

<b>Insurance:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants must be registered with their NF coach insurance scheme or privately</li> </ul>
