- ✓ 1x CSIO5\* or 3x CSIO2\*/CSIOY (145cm) or above in the last 6 years as a Course Designer
- ✓ 12x Grand Prix Competitions (150cm) or above at Intl. Events in the last 3 years as a Course Designer
- ✓ 2x CSI5\* as an Assistant Course Designer with a mentor Course Designer Level 4 with positive recommendations

### Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years

If passed, the transfer-up to level 4 is confirmed

- ✓ 3x CSI4\*/5\* (160cm) as Assistant Course Designer with a Mentor Course Designer Level 3 or above with positive recommendations
