



NOC STABLES SUPPLEMENTARY ACCESS CONTROL DEVICE (SACD) POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Access to the Tokyo 2020 stables compounds will be controlled through a special pass (Supplementary Access Control Device - SACD) which will be required in addition to Olympic Accreditation (zone 2). The stables SACDs will be distributed at the Sport Information Desk (SID) at Equestrian Park (EQP) in accordance with FEI Veterinary Rules, Article 1009, and the FEI Regulations for Equestrian Events at the Olympic Games (24th Edition), Article 621.

The SACD is non-transferable and will incorporate the name of the individual to whom it has been allocated. The exception to this will be stables SACDs allocated to holders of Training Access Passes (TAPs). These will be labelled as 'TAP Stables SACD' and may be transferred by the NOC in line with the transfer of a TAP from one NOC delegate to another NOC delegate in accordance with the Tokyo 2020 Training Access Pass policy and procedures.

1. Stables SACD distribution

The Stables SACD will be distributed to holders of Equestrian (EQU) Olympic Accreditation as follows:

- Category Ao (population including Coach, Team Leader, Technical Personnel, Administrative Personnel, Veterinarian)
- Category P (population: Personal Coach)
- Category Aa (population: Athlete)
- Category Ap (population: Alternate Athlete),
- Category Ao (population: Groom)
- Category P (population: Alternate Groom)
- Category NOC (population: Horse Support Personnel).

The following categories and populations will not have an automatic right to be allocated stables SACDs:

- Category Ao (population: Press Attaché)
- Category Ac (population: Olympic Attaché)
- Categories: NOC (populations other than Horse Support Personnel), NOC**, and U.



For the latter categories/populations and any other Olympic accredited guests/VIPs that an NOC may choose to invite in to the stables compound additional stables SACDs will be distributed accordingly to the number of entered horses per NOC per discipline as follows:

Total horses	Additional SACD for NOC
3-4 horses	2
1-2 horses	1

TAP Stables SACDs will be allocated according to the number of TAPs distributed to the NOC and may be transferred by the NOC in line with the transfer of a TAP from one NOC delegate to another NOC delegate in accordance with the Tokyo 2020 Training Access Pass policy and procedures. Each Stables TAP SACD will be labelled according to the NOC to which it has been provided.

2. How to apply and distribution process:

Once the NOC knows the names of its delegation members (after applying to DRM), they can email the Deputy Service Manager (Tatiana GUTIERREZ at tatiana.gutierrez@tokyo2020.jp) with the Sport Information Manager in copy (Honami MATSUI - honami.matsui@tokyo2020.jp), the spreadsheets in the last page of this document with all required details. This can either be done in advance of arrival or submitted by the relevant Team Leader/Chef d'Equipe in person at the Sports Information Desk at EQP.

3. Exceptions

Any exception to distribution of stables SACDs in accordance with this policy will be discussed with and must be approved by the FEI Veterinary Director and FEI Veterinary Technical Delegate.
