

## NATIONS CUP RANKING POINT SYSTEM FOR TOKYO 2020

**For the 24 month period 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2021**

The following is the point system for establishing a Nations Cup Ranking of all NFs taking part with a team in Nations Cup competitions at CSIO1\* to CSIO5\* events. NFs may earn points for the Nations Cup Ranking based on their classification in the Nations Cup competition at each CSIO for Seniors at which they take part, but may only count their four best results during the 24 month period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2021.

NB: For CSIO1\*/CSIO2\*/CSIO3\* events having taken place in 2019 in Division 2 Regional Groups A, B, C and D that served as qualification events for the 2019 Longines FEI Jumping Nations Cup™ Division 2 qualifier, points for the Nations Cup Ranking have been allocated according to the point scale established below for CSIO4\* events, as was required by the Longines FEI Jumping Nations Cup™ Rules in place at the time; the Nations Cup competitions at these events were built according to the specifications for CSIO4\* events as per JRs Art. 264.3.1.
