Horse Arrivals

Horse Arrivals

- NFs may work with shipping agent of their choice
- Official shipping agent being appointed by Paris 2024 to advise GL/OCOG and to be available to assist NFs with any import/export matters
- NFs will be required to submit movement details (D-15 to D+15) to official shipping agent, including date of entry to France & customs status
- Short arrival/departure windows – staging available at Haras du Jardy less than 20mins from venue

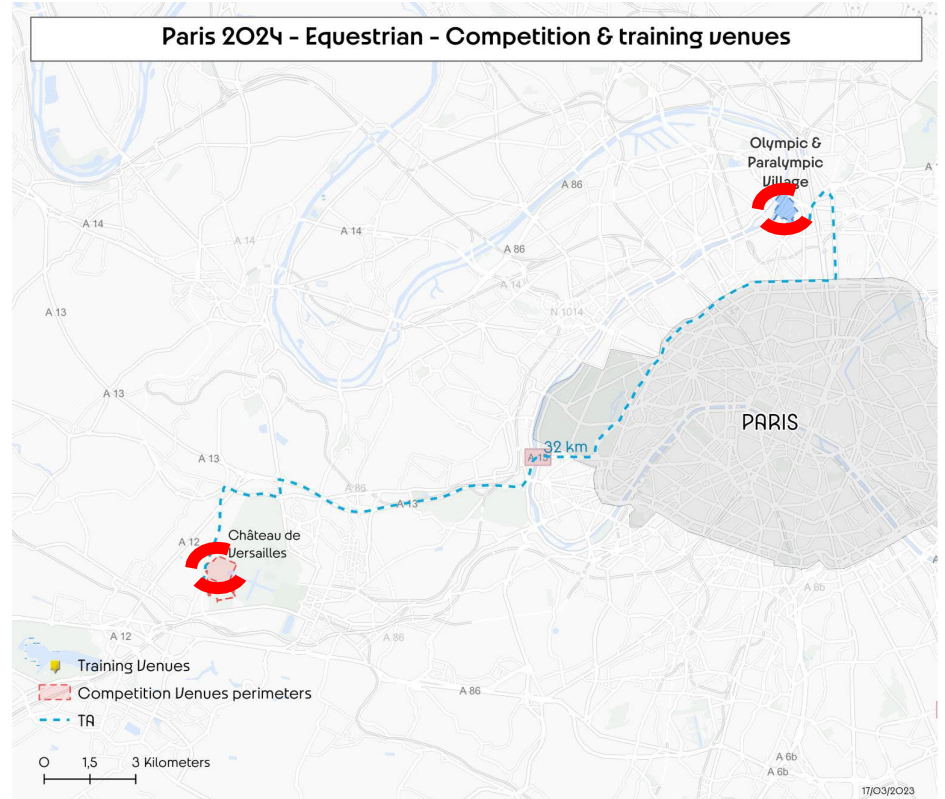

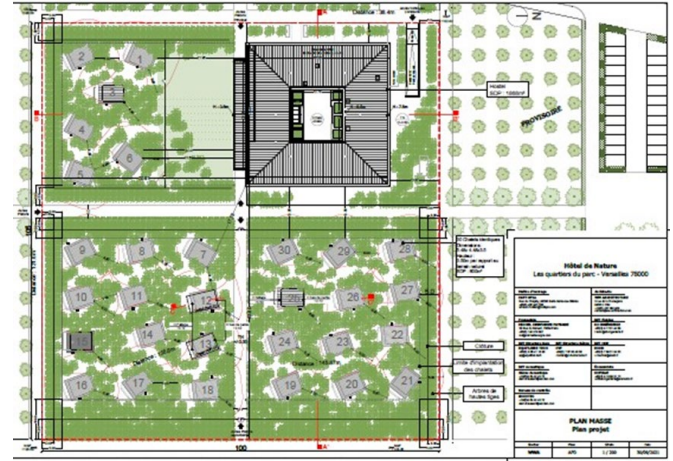

31 Dec	End of Olympic ranking period
31 Dec	Deadline for NOCs/NFs to obtain NOC Certificate of Capability to confirm team qualifications – 3 different Athlete/Horse combinations per NF to have achieved Olympic MERs
2024	
8 Jan	Submission of NOC Certificate of Capability to FEI
10 Jan	NOCs/NFs to be informed by FEI of their allocated team quota place
15 Jan	Registration and change of Horse Ownership/Nationality deadline (see next slide)
5 Feb	NOCs/NFs to confirm or decline allocated team quota place to FEI
19 Feb	NOCs/NFs to be informed by FEI of their allocated individual quota places and composite team(s) quota place(s)
18 Mar	NOCs/NFs to confirm allocated individual & composite team quota places to FEI (confirmed according to IOC approved qualification procedure)
28 Mar	NOCs/NFs to nominate long list of potential Athletes to Paris 2024 (date confirmed as amended by IOC/Paris 2024)
24 Jun	Deadline for achieving MERs for all Athlete/Horse combinations
25 Jun	NFs to send Certificates of Capability to FEI
8 Jul	Paris 2024 Sport Entry deadline – NOCs submit final entries

Paralympic Games – Key Dates

- **31 Dec:** End of the period for Athletes performances to be recorded on the FEI Paralympic Ranking Lists
- **19 Feb:** Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation Application Process
- **4 Mar:** NPCs notified of number of allocated qualification slots
- **18 Mar:** NPCs confirm use of allocated qualification slots / Deadline for NPCs to submit Bipartite Commission Invitation applications
- **25 Mar:** FEI confirms in writing the reallocation of unused qualification slots and the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitations
- **3 May:** Accreditation Deadline
- **19 Jun:** Deadline for achieving MERs / Certificates of Capability to FEI / Nominated Entries
- **5 Aug:** Final entry deadline



Rule Clarifications

Registration & Change of Horse Ownership/Nationality (Olympic Games only)

- **Mon 15 Jan 2024**: Deadline for all Paris 2024 Horses to be registered in FEI Database with same nationality as competing Olympic Games Athlete
- Horse's nationality is that of its Owner. Owner can be a person or a company. If a company, the nationality is the country where company is registered.
- Horse owned by multiple owners of different nationalities - must be registered in FEI Database under the name of the nation that the horse will compete for in Paris 2024 by **15 Jan 2024**
- If a Horse changes nationality after **15 Jan 2024**, ineligible to compete at Paris 2024
- NFs should check all their potential Paris 2024 Horses on the FEI Database
- **15 Jan 2024** deadline is a strict deadline; no exceptions

Qualification Procedure – Explanation

EVENTING - Individual qualification - Allocation of quota

For Eventing a NOC can qualify for a **maximum of two (2) individual places**, either through their FEI Olympic Group or through the overall FEI Olympic Ranking, or both.

Each athlete can obtain a maximum of one (1) individual quota place for their NOC.

*A NOC can therefore earn up to two individual quota places via the FEI Olympic Group Rankings
14 Individual Quota places are allocated via the FEI Olympic Group Rankings and 3 Individual Quota places are allocated via the overall FEI Olympic Ranking.*

DRESSAGE - Individual qualification - Allocation of quota

For Dressage the allocation through FEI Olympic Groups, a NOC can qualify for a **maximum of one (1) individual place**.

Should the overall quota of 60 places not have been filled after completing the reallocation process, the leftover quota places will be allocated via the overall FEI Olympic Rankings Dressage and a NOC that has already earned/accepted an Individual quota place is entitled to a second Individual quota place.

Qualification Procedure – Explanation

EVENTING - Individual qualification - Allocation of quota

FEI Olympic Group D & E (North America, Central & South America)

4 quota places will be allocated from FEI Olympic Groups D and E, so if there are no Group D individuals available to claim an individual quota place (if their NOC has a team quota place already), the 4 best ranked individuals from Group E would obtain them.

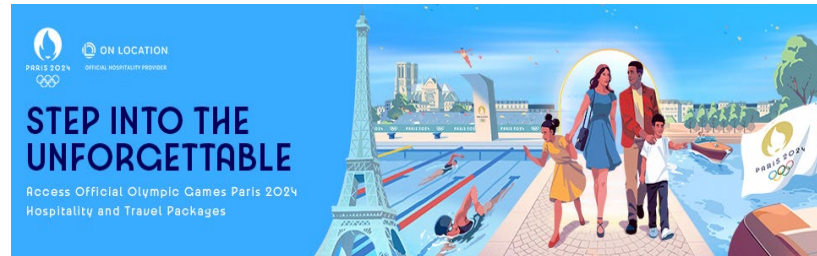
