 - ✓ Be in good standing with the FEI
- Officiating experience within 10 years of application**
- ✓ 3 CPEDIs 3* as a Para Equestrian Chief Classifier
 - ✓ 10 completed Athlete Evaluations

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
 - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
 - ✓ Confirm the Authority to Practice via the Annual Disclosure Declaration
 - ✓ 3 intl. events within the last 3 years as a Level 4 Para Equestrian Chief Classifier ¹
- ¹ The CES Officiating Review will not be applied, by decision of the FEI Board on 5 June 2024.

- For Transfer-up**
- ✓ Pass the Level 4 Para Equestrian Classifiers blended learning programme with examination(s)
 - Online Level 4 Para Equestrian Classifiers examination
 - Online interview
 - In-person course of 3 days

- ✓ On passing the Level 4 final blended learning programme with examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 4 Para Equestrian Classifiers (PED & PEA) in the FEI Database

 - ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
 - ✓ Confirm the Authority to Practice via the Annual Disclosure Declaration
 - ✓ 1 intl. event within the last 3 years as a Level 3 Para Equestrian Classifier ¹

Education

- For Transfer-up**
- ✓ Pass a Level 3 Para Equestrian Classifiers transfer-up course with examination
 - ✓ Pass 1 positive shadow classification at a CPEDI with a defined set of activities associated with the role of Para Equestrian Chief Classifier, within 3 months after the transfer-up course

- ✓ Complete 4 Athlete Evaluations with a positive recommendation from a Level 3 Para Equestrian Classifier at a minimum of 2 CPEDIs in the last three years

- ✓ On passing the Level 2 examination(s) and fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 2 Para Equestrian Classifiers (PED & PEA) in the FEI Database



Trainee Classifier

Requirements

- ✓ English proficiency grade of A2 or higher
- ✓ Formally recommended by National Federation
- ✓ Completed online Para Dressage Foundation Course-
- ✓ Hold a current Authority to Practice within a nominated health profession in home country
- ✓ Experience as a National Para Equestrian Classifier

Maintenance

- ✓ CES Online Assessment every year
- ✓ CES Maintenance Course every 3 years
- ✓ Confirm the Authority to Practice via the Annual Disclosure Declaration

Education

- For National Para Equestrian Classifiers**
- ✓ Be mentored by 1 or more Level 2 or above Para Equestrian Classifiers (Mentor Classifiers) for the entire duration of their Level 1 Status

- Level 1 Para Equestrian Classifier**
- ✓ After fulfilling all requirements, participants are listed as Level 1 Para Equestrian Classifiers (PED & PEA) in the FEI Database
